

finished quilt measures 65" x 70"

Note: Sew an exact 1/4" seam for all the pieces to fit properly.

Cutting Directions

FROM	CUT	TO YIELD
Panel	(16) 9" x 8" rectangles	(16) animal blocks, 9" tall x 8" wide
Each fat quarter	(6) 2" x 21" strips	sashing (108 strips total)
Red print	(8) 2" x 42" strips	(153) 2" squares
	(7) 2-1/2'' x WOF	Border
	(7) 2-1/4'' x WOF	Binding

Cutting and Assembling the Blocks

Step 1) From each of a variety of (32) 2" x 21" print strips, cut a 2" x 8" and a 2" x 12" sashing rectangle.

Step 2) From each of a variety of (32) 2" x 21" print strips, cut a 2" x 9" and a 2" x 11" sashing rectangle.


Step 3) From the remaining (44) 2" \times 21" print strips, cut (20) 2" \times 14" sashing rectangles and (20) 2" \times 15" sashing rectangles.




Step 4) Sew red cornerstones to both ends of the 2" x 8" and the 2" x 11" sashing rectangles. Press away from the print strips. Set aside to be used in Steps 6 and 8.



Step 5) Sew the 2" x 9" print strips to the long sides of each of the animal blocks. Press toward the print strips. Make 16 blocks.



Step 6) Sew the 2" x 8" sashing rectangles with red cornerstones to the top and bottom of each of the blocks. Press toward the sashing strips. Make 16 blocks.



Step 7) Sew the 2" x 12" sashing rectangles to the sides of the blocks from Step 6. Press toward the sashing strips just added. Make 16 blocks.



Step 8 Sew the 2" x 11" sashing rectangles with red cornerstones to the top and bottom of each of the blocks. Press toward the sashing strips just added. Make 16 blocks.



Step 9) Sew the 2" \times 15" sashing rectangles between four of the blocks. Sew 2" \times 15" sashing rectangles at both ends of the row. Press toward the sashing rectangles just added. Make four rows. (Refer to quilt photo)

Step 10) Sew 5 rows of horizontal sashing strips using 5 cornerstones and 4—2" x 14" sashing rectangles in each row. Press toward the sashing rectangles.



Step 11) Join the Step 9 block rows and the Step 10 horizontal sashing rows to complete the quilt top. Press toward the horizontal sashing rows.

Borders

Join the border ends with diagonal seams pressed open. Trim two borders to the width of the quilt. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Trim two borders the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt, pressing toward the borders.

Finishing the Quilt

Layer, baste and quilt as desired. Before binding, hand or machine-baste a scant 1/4" from the edge of the quilt to hold the layers together and prevent shifting.

Prepare the binding by joining the 2-1/4" wide binding strips with diagonal seams pressed open. Press the binding in half, wrong sides together. Sew to the quilt with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, mitering the corners.

Trim the excess batting and backing, turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
