Finished quilt measures: $47^{\prime \prime} \times 56^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## Set Fabric A aside for the Embroidered Blocks section.

From Fabric B, cut:
fourteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two-hundred and eight-four 2" squares.
From Fabric C, cut:
three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty 2 " squares.
From Fabric D, cut:
one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twelve 2" squares.
From Fabric E , cut:
three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-eight 2" squares.

## From Fabric F , cut:

five $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to end, then subcut:
two 4-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer side borders. two 4-1/2" $\times 47-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer top/bottom borders.
one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut: sixteen 2" squares.

From Fabric G, cut:
five 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 2 " x 45-1/2" inner side borders.
two 2" $\times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inner top/bottom borders.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips.

Step 1: Embroider the eight different blocks from the Fabric A panel that are shown on the cover image. Use red embroidery floss, with one thread for all outline stitches; two threads for Lazy Daisy and French knot stitches.

Step 2: Hand wash and rinse the blocks after embroidering. Let dry flat. Press right side down on a towel or wool pressing mat. Trim each block to 9-1/2" square.

## Assemble the Blocks

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Step 3: Gather twenty-four 2" Fabric B squares, six 2" Fabric C squares, and six 2" Fabric D squares. Arrange the squares in six rows of six as shown.

Step 4: Sew the rows together and press the seams of each even row to the right and the seams of each odd row to the left. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams open or to one side.

Step 5: Repeat Steps 3-4 to make eight A blocks.
These blocks will measure $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Step 6: Gather twelve 2" Fabric B squares, three Fabric C squares, and three Fabric E squares. Arrange the squares in six rows of three as shown.

Step 7: Sew the rows together and press the seams of each even row to the right and the seams of each odd row to the left. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams open or to one side.

Step 8: Repeat Steps 6-7 to make two B blocks.
These blocks will measure 5 " $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Step 9: Repeat Steps 6-7 to make two mirrored B Blocks. These blocks will measure 5 " $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Make two of each.


Step 10: Gather twenty-two 2" Fabric B squares, six 2" Fabric D squares, and eight 2" Fabric F squares. Arrange the squares in six rows of six as shown.

Step 11: Sew the rows together and press the seams of each even row to the right and the seams of each odd row to the left. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams open or to one side.

Step 12: Repeat Steps 10-11 to make two C blocks. These blocks will measure $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.



Step 12: Arrange the blocks and embroidered squares into five rows. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 13: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

Step 14: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Step 15: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 16: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
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
