## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

five 4-1/2" x WOF strips for strip sets.

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips for strip sets.

### **From each of Fabric C-E, cut:**

one 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 8-1/2" squares.

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

fourteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

three 12-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seven 12-7/8" squares.

Subcut five squares once on the diagonal to yield ten large triangles.

Trim two squares to 9-3/8".

Subcut the two squares once on the diagonal to yield four small triangles.

### **From Fabric H, cut:**

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 68-1/2" side borders.


two 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" top/bottom borders.

### **From the Binding Fabric, cut**


eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Make the A Blocks


**Step 1:** Gather two 4-1/2" Fabric A strips and one 4-1/2" Fabric B strip. Sew the strips together lengthwise with the Fabric B strip in the center. Press towards the Fabric A strips. Make two strip sets.




**Step 2:** Cut a total of fourteen 4-1/2" segments from the strip sets.




**Step 3:** Gather two 4-1/2" Fabric B strips and one 4-1/2" Fabric A strip. Sew the strips together lengthwise with the Fabric A strip in the center. Press towards the Fabric A strips.



**Step 4:** Cut a total of seven 4-1/2" segments from the strip set.




**Step 5:** Gather two A/B/A segments and one B/A/B segment. Nest the seams, then sew the three strips together as shown to form a nine-patch. Press the seams open or to one side. Make seven blocks.




## Make the B Blocks


**Step 6:** Gather one 8-1/2" Fabric C square, two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric F rectangles, and two 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric F rectangles. Sew the two shorter Fabric F rectangles to two opposite sides of the Fabric C square. Press towards the rectangles.




**Step 7:** Sew the two longer Fabric F rectangles to the two remaining sides of the Fabric C square. Press towards the rectangles.




Repeat to make:



four Fabric C blocks



four Fabric D blocks



four Fabric E blocks



**Step 8:** Arrange the blocks and Fabric G triangles into diagonal rows. Note the fabric and block placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. *Hint: The small triangles are placed in the four corners of the quilt.*

**Step 9:** Sew the blocks and triangles together to form the diagonal rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

**Step 10:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open. If needed, trim the edges of the quilt top leaving at least 1/4" past the corners of the blocks on the outer edge of the quilt.



**Step 11:** Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
