## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:
twenty-three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
forty $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
forty 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
forty 2-1/2" squares
Tip: In order to maximize the yardage, cut two each of the 8-1/2", 6-1/2" and 4-1/2" rectangles from each of the first twenty strips, then cut the $2-1 / 2$ " squares from the remaining three.

From each of Fabrics C-L, cut:
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
eight 2-1/2" squares

## From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the A Blocks

Step 1: Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square on top of a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, at the right edge of the rectangle. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " and press.


Step 2: Place a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle on top of a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, at the right edge of Fabric C. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press.

Step 3: Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle on top of a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, at the right edge of Fabric C. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press.



Step 4: Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C square on top of a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, at the left edge of the rectangle. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press.

Step 5: Sew the Step 1-4 units together to form the block. Press. The block will measure 8-1/2" square.


Step 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to make a total of:

two A Blocks from Fabric C

four A Blocks from Fabric F

five A Blocks from Fabric D

seven A Blocks from Fabric G

three A Blocks from Fabric E

two A Blocks from Fabric H

three A Blocks from Fabric I
six A Blocks from Fabric L


five A Blocks from Fabric J

three A Blocks from Fabric K

## Assemble the B Blocks

Step 7: Place a 2-1/2" Fabric B square on top of a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric C rectangle, at the right edge of the rectangle. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " and press.


Step 8: Place a 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle on top of a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, at the right edge of Fabric C. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " and press.

Step 9: Place a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangle on top of a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, at the right edge of Fabric C. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " and press.


Step 10: Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $C$ square on top of a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2$ " Fabric B rectangle, at the left edge of the rectangle. Sew on the diagonal, as shown. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " and press.

Step 11: Sew the Step 7-10 units together to form the block. Press. The block will measure 8-1/2" square.


Step 12: Repeat Steps 7-1 1 to make a total of:

six B Blocks from Fabric C

four B Blocks from Fabric F
five B Blocks from Fabric I


three B Blocks from Fabric D

one B Block from Fabric G

three B Blocks from Fabric J

five B Blocks from Fabric E

six B Blocks from Fabric H

five B Blocks from Fabric K

two B Blocks from Fabric L

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 13: Arrange the $A$ and $B$ Blocks into ten rows of eight blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 14: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 15: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!


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
