
DIAMOND STRIPES

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics O-R and CC-KK, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

a total of sixteen 3" x 8" rectangle for the corner blocks (one each from ten fabrics and two each from three fabrics)

Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2" for subcutting the rectangles below

From each of Fabrics A-KK, cut:

one to two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut to yield a total of: one hundred 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for the blocks eighty-two 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the borders

Tip: You will cut 2-3 of the 10-1/2" rectangles from each fabric and 1-2 of the 5-1/2" rectangles from each fabric.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Tip: Refer to the cover sample for general color groupings, if you wish to replicate the look of the cover. Group the 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips in sets of five before sewing.

- **Step 1:** Using five of the 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips, sew together to make one 10-1/2" square. Repeat with all the strips to make twenty blocks.
- **Step 2:** Cut these blocks in half diagonally, varying the direction of the diagonal to give variety when you piece them back together.
- **Step 3:** Take any two triangles and sew together along the diagonal. Repeat with all the triangles to make twenty blocks. Tip: Pin before sewing to prevent stretching along the bias edge.
- **Step 4:** Press the blocks and trim to 9-1/2" square.

Make the Borders

Step 5: For the top and bottom borders sew two rows of eighteen 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips. For the left and right borders sew two rows of twenty-three 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips. For each border, sew the strips together along their longest side.

Tip: Refer to the finished sample for general color placement for the left and right borders, if you wish for the colors to move from warm to cool.

Make the Corner Blocks

Step 6: Using the paper piecing templates and 3" strips make four corner blocks. Trim to 5-1/2" square.

Assemble the Quilt

- **Step 7:** Sew together the central blocks in five rows of four. This quilt center should measure 36-1/2" x 45-1/2".
- **Step 8:** Trim the left and right border pieces to 45-1/2" in length, if necessary, pin in place and sew to the left and right edges.
- **Step 9:** Trim the top and bottom border pieces to 36-1/2" in length, if necessary. Sew a corner block on each end, making sure the corner blocks point inward and down for the top border and inward and up for the bottom border.
- **Step 10:** Sew these borders on to your quilt. Press.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!


Templates

Print at 100%.

Check size printed correctly using 1" box for scale prior to cutting fabric.

Make four of template.

1" box for scale



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
