

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

# **Cutting Instructions**

#### From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

one 9" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 9" squares two 3" squares one 2" square three 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: one 7-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle two 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles three 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles five 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles six 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles seven 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles two 8" x WOF strips. Subcut: seven 8" squares one 7" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 7" squares

one 6" x WOF strips. Subcut:
five 6" squares
three 4" squares
one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles
one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 5" squares
four 4-1/2" squares
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles

### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a Fabric A square with a Fabric B square of the same size, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Make the quantities and trim each HST unit to the sizes listed in the chart below.



Fabric A Square	Fabric B Square	HST Trim Size	Quantity of HST Size
2" square	2" square	1-1/2" square	Make two.
3" square	3" square	2-1/2" square	Make four.
4" square	4" square	3-1/2" square	Make six.
5" square	5" square	4-1/2" square	Make eight.
6" square	6" square	5-1/2" square	Make ten.
7" square	7" square	6-1/2" square	Make twelve.
8" square	8" square	7-1/2" square	Make fourteen.
9" square	9" square	8-1/2" square	Make eight.*

<sup>\*</sup>One 8-1/2" HST can be discarded.

#### Assemble the Blocks

**Step 2:** Sew one 1-1/2"  $\times$  7-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of one 1-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 7-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press.



**Step 3:** Sew one 2-1/2"  $\times$  6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of one 2-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 6-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press. Make two.



**Step 4:** Sew one 3-1/2"  $\times$  5-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of one 3-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 5-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press. Make three.



**Step 5:** Sew one 4-1/2" Fabric A square to the left edge of one 4-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press. Make four.



**Step 6:** Sew one 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of one 5-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press. Make five.



**Step 7:** Sew one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of one 6-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press. Make six.



**Step 8:** Sew one 1-1/2"  $\times$  7-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of one 7-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 1-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of the unit. Press. Make seven.



**Step 9:** Sew one 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the right edge of one 7-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make seven.



**Step 10:** Sew one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the right edge of one 6-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make six.



**Step 11:** Sew one 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the right edge of one 5-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make five.



**Step 12:** Sew one 4-1/2" Fabric B square to the right edge of one 4-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 4-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make four.



**Step 13:** Sew one 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the right edge of one 3-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make three.




**Step 14:** Sew one 2-1/2"  $\times$  6-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the right edge of one 2-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 6-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make two.



**Step 15:** Sew one 1-1/2"  $\times$  7-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the right edge of one 7-1/2" HST as shown, then press. Sew one 7-1/2"  $\times$  8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press.





**Step 16:** Arrange the blocks into nine rows of seven blocks. Note the block placement and orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 17:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

**Step 18:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
