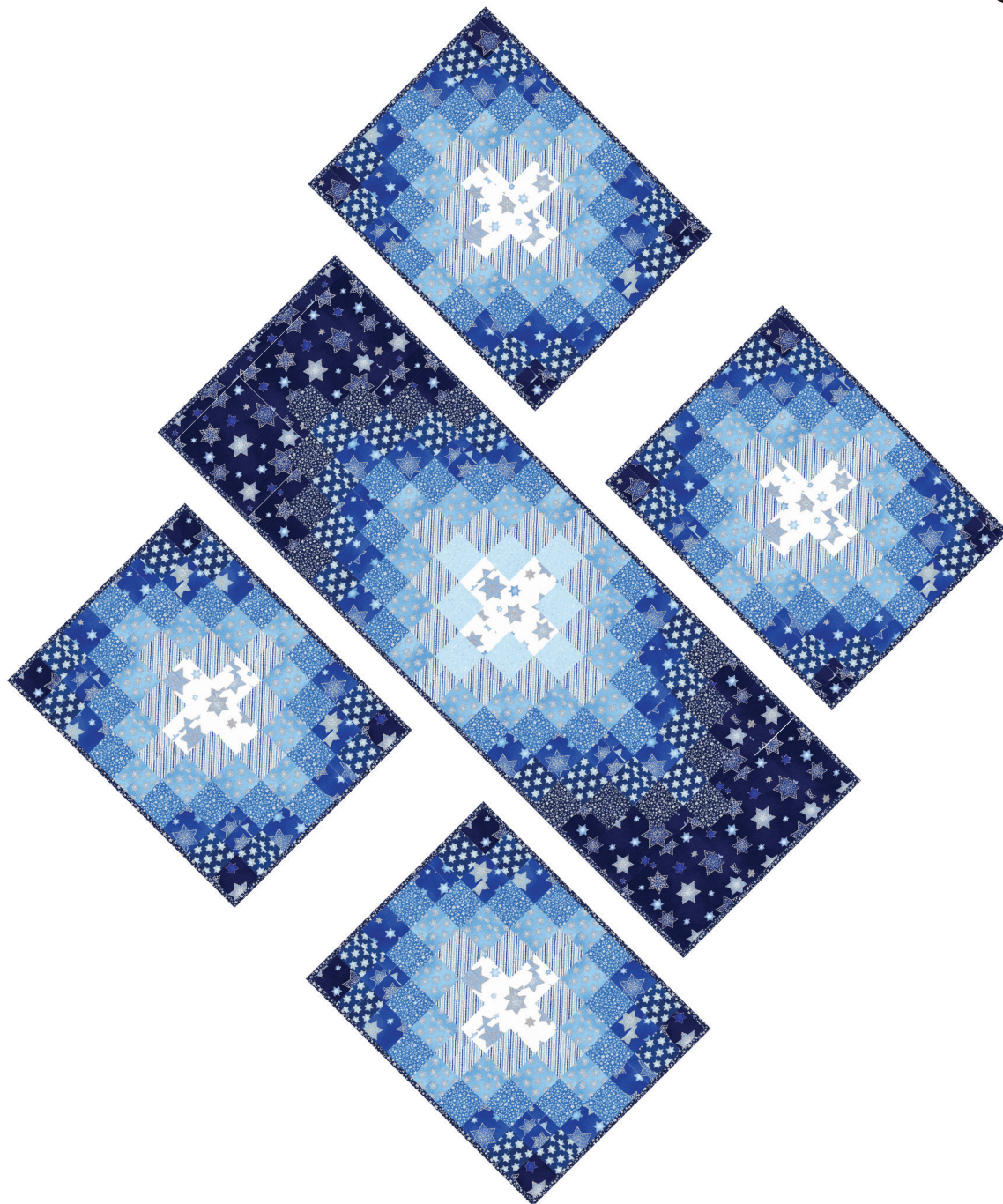




## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

**From Fabric A, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" squares

**From each of Fabrics B and F, cut:**

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
sixty-two 2-1/2" squares

**From Fabric C, cut:**

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty-six 2-1/2" squares

**From Fabric D, cut:**

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty-four 2-1/2" squares

**From Fabric E, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
fourteen 2-1/2" squares

**From Fabric G, cut:**

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
seventy 2-1/2" squares

**From Fabric H, cut:**

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
two 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles  
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty 2-1/2" squares  
four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles  
four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

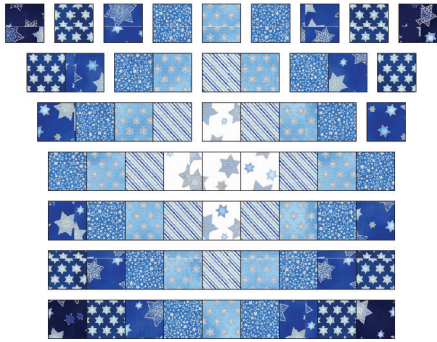
**From Fabric I, cut:**

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty-five 2-1/2" squares

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Placemats



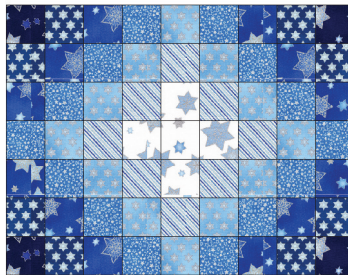
### Step 1: Gather:

five Fabric I squares  
eight Fabric D squares  
twelve Fabric B squares  
fourteen Fabric G squares  
twelve Fabric F squares  
eight Fabric C squares  
four Fabric H squares

Arrange the units into seven rows of nine. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 2:** Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

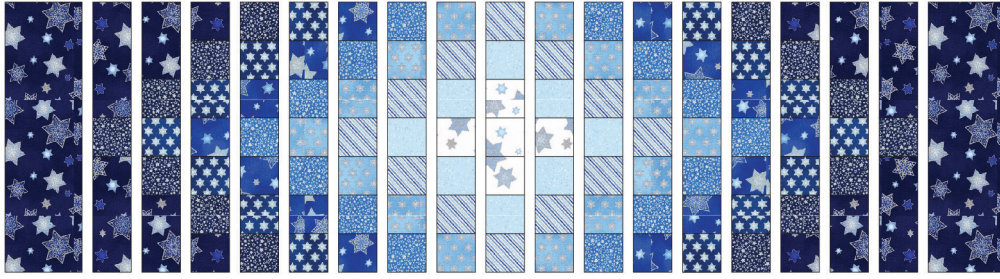
**Step 3:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the placemat.



The resulting Placemat should measure 14-1/2" x 18-1/2". Repeat to make four Placemats.



## Assemble the Table Runner



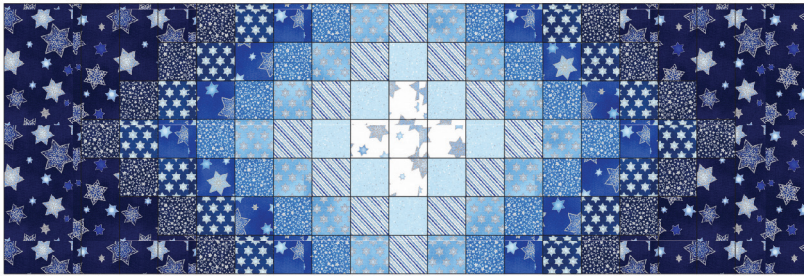
**Step 1:** Gather the remaining Fabric A-I squares, and the 2-1/2" wide Fabric H rectangles

Arrange the units into seventeen columns. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 2:** Sew the squares and 2-1/2" wide rectangles together to form the columns. Press the seams in opposite directions every other column.

**Step 3:** Sew the columns together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the placemat.

**Step 4:** Sew the 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles to opposite ends of the Table Runner.



The resulting Table Runner should measure 14-1/2" x 42-1/2".

Your Table Runner and Placemat set is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
