Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Color	Fabric	Name/SKU	Yardage	
	A	AMF-16669-4 BLUE	1/4 yard	<p>You will also need: Bath or hand towels (optional) 3/8"-1/2" Grosgrain ribbon: 1 yard per hand towel and 2-1/4 yards per bath towel</p>
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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Pre-wash and dry both the towel and the fabric. Press both.

Step 1: First, decide your desired width of accent fabric on the towel. For hand towels, 3 to 3-1/2" is best and for bath towels, 4 to 4-1/2" is best. Add 1/2" to the finished width of fabric you would like.

Cut one WOF strip of the size you chose.

Embellish the Towel

Step 2: For towels without grosgrain ribbon, fold both long edges under by 1/4" and press. Fold one short end under by 1/4" and press.

Step 3: Place the fabric face up on the accent strip of the towel, aligning the short folded end of the fabric with the edge of the towel. Pin in place along both long sides. Trim the fabric to 1/4" beyond the far edge of the towel. Fold this end under by 1/4" and press.

Step 4: Edge stitch all four sides of the fabric 1/8" from the edges.

Step 5: If using the optional grosgrain ribbon, cut two lengths of ribbon 1/2" longer than the length of the fabric accent strip. Tuck each end of the ribbon under by 1/4" and center the length of ribbon along the long edges of the fabric. Edge stitch along all four edges of the ribbon.
