Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

nine 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighty 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Sew the remaining strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 63" side borders

two 4-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom borders

eleven 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

nine 3" x 50-1/2" sashing strips

From each of Fabrics B-K, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle of each fabric

two 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

two 4-1/2" squares of each fabric

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

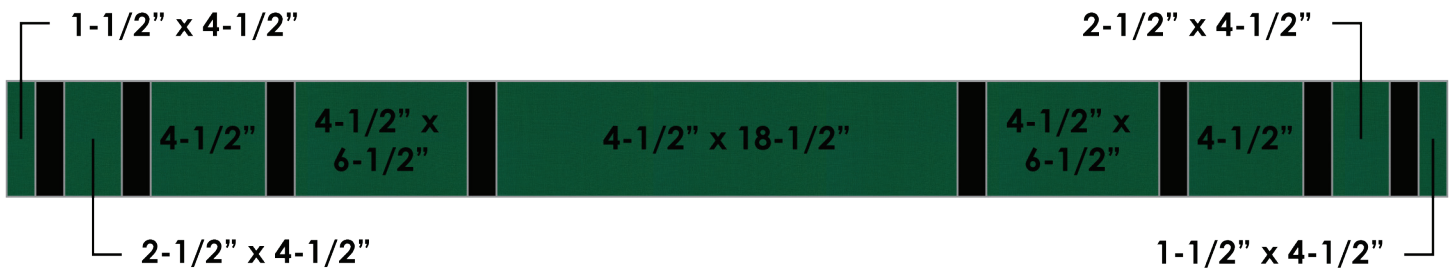
two 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

From the Binidng Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Rows

Step 1: Gather eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangles and all of the squares and rectangles cut from Fabric B. Sew the gathered pieces together to form a row as shown. Press.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make nine additional rows using Fabrics C-K in place of Fabric B.





Assemble the Quilt

Step 3: Arrange the rows to form the quilt top. Note the fabric placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Place a sashing strip between each of the rows.

Step 5: Sew the rows and sashing strips together to form the quilt center. Press the seams open.

Step 6: Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
