Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 10-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics B-D, cut:

one 10-1/2" square

From Fabric E, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

six 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" row sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" side inner borders

two 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From each of Fabrics F-K, cut:

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 2-1/2" squares for the pieced block borders

From Fabric L, cut:

two 4-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" side outer borders

From the remaining width of fabric, cut:

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Block Units



Step 1: Gather: twelve Fabric F squares twelve Fabric G squares one Fabric A square

Arrange the Fabric F and G squares to form the side block borders, alternating a total of five Fabric F and G as shown. Press. Repeat this process with a total of seven Fabric F and G units to form the top and bottom block borders, as shown. Press. Sew the side borders to the left and right edges of the Fabric A square. Press. Sew the top and bottom block borders to the top and bottom of the block unit. Press.

The resulting Block should measure 14-1/2" square.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make a total of nine Blocks, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric pairings.

Assemble the Quilt

Step 3: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

Step 4: Sew the sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 5: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 6: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is finished! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
