Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

one 9-1/2" square

From Fabric C, cut:

sixteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 2" x 9-1/2" strips

eighteen 2" x 12-1/2" strips

Sew the remaining five strips together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 2" x 47-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces

two 2" x 44-1/2" side Border 2 pieces

From Fabric D, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Sew the remainder of the full and partial strips together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

two 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

From Fabric E, cut:

three 4-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 4-1/2" x 55-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 pieces

From the remaining width of fabric, cut:

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 4-1/2" x 47-1/2" side Border 3 pieces

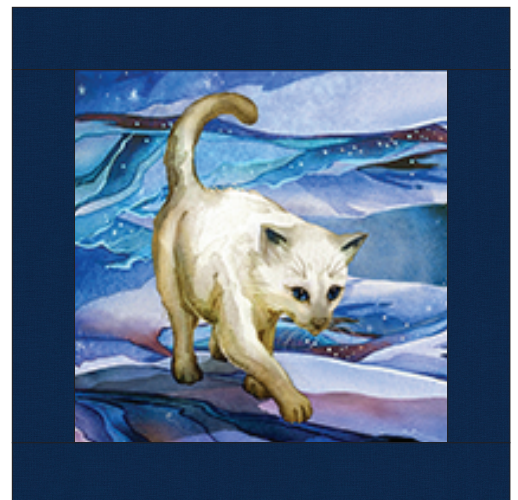
From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Sew a 2" x 9-1/2" Fabric C strip to the left and right edges of a Fabric A square. Press. Sew a 2" x 12-1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom edges of a Fabric A square. Press. The resulting block should measure 12-1/2" square.

Repeat with all Fabric A squares and the Fabric B square for a total of nine blocks.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 2: Arrange the Blocks together in three rows of three, as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

Step 3: Sew the 40-1/2" long sashing strips and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams, placing a sashing strip between each row. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 4: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 5: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 6: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
