#### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

#### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

one 28-1/2" x 40-1/2" center panel

#### From Fabric B, cut:

two 7" x WOF strips. Subcut: ten 7" squares for the Large HSTs two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 6-1/2" squares six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" x 64-1/2" side Border 3 strips two 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty 3" square for the Small HSTs ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: one hundred 2-1/2" squares

Sew the remaining three strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

#### two 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" side Border 1 strips two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

#### From each of Fabrics C-G, cut:

one 7" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 7" squares for the Large HSTs

#### From Fabric H, cut:

three 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 6-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips

#### From each of Fabrics I-L and N-R, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 3" squares for the Small HSTs

#### From Fabric M, cut:

seven 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 5-1/2" x 76-1/2" side Border 4 strips two 5-1/2" x 70-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 strips one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 3" squares for the Small HSTs

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 7" Fabric B square with a 7" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 6-1/2" square. Repeat to make four B/C HSTs.



#### Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:





four B/D HSTs

These will be referred to as the Large HSTs.

four B/E HSTs







**Step 3:** Repeat Step 1, this time using the 3" B and I-R squares, to make:



#### Assemble the Star Block Units



**Step 4:** Gather: four B/I Small HSTs five 2-1/2" Fabric B squares

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.


**Step 5:** Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams toward the squares.

**Step 6:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the 6-1/2" square Star Block.



Step 7: Repeat Steps 4-6 to make two Star Blocks from each of Fabrics I-R.

**Step 8:** Sew one of each of the Fabric I-R Star Blocks (in that order) together to make one Star Block Unit. Press. Repeat to make a second unit like this.



#### Assemble the Border 2 Units

**Step 9:** Gather: three 6-1/2" Fabric B squares two B/C HSTs two B/D HSTs two B/E HSTs

Arrange the units to form a row. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Assembly Diagram. Sew together and press. Repeat to make a second unit like this. These are the top/bottom Border 2 units.





**Step 10:** Gather: one 6-1/2" Fabric B square two B/F HSTs two B/G HSTs


Arrange the units to form a column. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Assembly Diagram. Sew together and press. Repeat to make a second unit like this. These are the left/right Border 2 units.

Assemble the Quilt

**Step 11:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 12:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 13:** Sew the 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" Fabric A strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the strips. Sew the 6-1/2" x 54-1/2" Fabric H strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the strips.



**Step 14:** Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 15:** Sew the Star Block Units to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the Border 3 strips.

**Step 16:** Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
