Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and D, cut:

two 9" squares


From Fabric B, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- eight 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles
- eight 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangles

two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- eight 6-1/2" squares
- From the remainder of the second strip, cut: four 5-1/8" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, for a total of sixteen triangles.




From each of Fabrics C and F, cut:

two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

• eight 6-1/2" squares

two 7-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, forming a total of eight triangles from each fabric.



From Fabric E, cut:

one 5-1/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

 eight 5-1/8" squares. Cut each square in half once along the diagonal, for a total of sixteen triangles.



From Fabric G, fussy cut:

five 20-1/2" squares

From Fabric H, cut:

seven 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to form:

- two 6-1/2" x 60-1/2" side border strips
- two 6-1/2" x 72-1/2" top and bottom border strips

From the binding fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks

Step 1: Sew a Fabric E triangles to adjacent sides of a Fabric F square. Press seams toward the square. Repeat to make eight units. Set four aside for Step 3.






Step 2: Sew a Fabric F triangle to either side of a Step 1 unit. Repeat to make four units.

Step 3: Gather two Step 1 units, two Step 2 units and one Fabric D square. Sew together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Note the orientation of directional fabrics as you assemble the block. Trim to 18-1/2" square, if necessary.

Step 4: Sew a 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strip to the sides of the block and press toward the strip. Sew a 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the block and press toward the strip. Repeat to make two A Blocks.

Assemble the B Blocks



Step 5: Repeat Steps 1-4 to form the B Blocks, using the Fabric A, B and C pieces. Make two B Blocks.



Step 6: Arrange the two A Blocks, two B Blocks and five Fabric G squares into three rows of three, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew the blocks into rows, pressing the seams toward the Fabric G squares. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams open.

Step 7: Sew the $6-1/2" \times 60-1/2"$ border to the sides of the quilt top. Press toward the border. Sew the $6-1/2" \times 72-1/2"$ border to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward the border.
