

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 9-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

two 10-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 9-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

two 10-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" side sashing strips
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" top/bottom sashing strips

From Fabric D, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-five 2-1/2" squares

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 4-1/2" x 63" top and bottom mitered border strips

From the remaining yardage, cut:

six 4-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 4-1/2" x 67" side mitered border strips

From Fabric E, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" top and bottom inner border strips

two 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" side inner border strips

From the binding fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt Center



Step 1: Arrange the Fabric A and Fabric B Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" side sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.


Step 2: Gather five cornerstone squares and four sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five sashing rows.

Step 3: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Add the Borders

Step 4: Sew the Fabric E top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric E side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 5: Center and pin one side outer border to the quilt top. Sew the border, starting and stopping 1/4" from each end of the quilt top. Repeat with the remaining side outer border. Repeat with the top and bottom borders. Note: borders will extend beyond the quilt's edge.



Step 6: Fold the quilt diagonally, right sides together and align two of the borders directly on top of each other.

Use your ruler to draw a line from the corner of the quilt to the edge of the border.



Step 7: Sew along this marked line, beginning at the point where your border stitching had ended and sew to the edge of the border. Check to be sure the mitered border presses flat from the front, then trim 1/4" away from the marked line, removing the excess border length.





Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
