Finished quilt measures: $66^{\prime \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric $A$, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: sixteen 2-1/2" squares for Piece 1

From Fabric B, cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 2-1/2" squares for Piece 2 sixteen 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Piece 3
six $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders
two 2 " $\times 59-1 / 2$ " side inner borders
From Fabric C, cut:
five $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Piece 4 sixteen 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Piece 5

## From Fabric D, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Piece 6 sixteen $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Piece 7

## From Fabric E, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for Piece 8 sixteen 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for Piece 9

## From Fabric F, cut:

ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Piece 10 sixteen 2-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Piece 11

## From Fabric G, cut:

six $4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4 " x 59-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
two $4 " \times 66-1 / 2 "$ side outer borders
fourteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles for Piece 12 sixteen 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles for Piece 13

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips


Step 1: Gather: one each of Pieces 1-13

Arrange the units together to form a log cabin block. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew Piece 1 to the top edge of Piece 2, as shown. Press away from Piece 1. Sew Piece 3 to the right edge of the unit and press away from Piece 1. Continue sewing Pieces $4-13$ in the order and position shown in the diagram, always pressing to the outer edge.

The final block should measure 14-1/2" square.
Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make a total of sixteen Blocks.

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 3: Arrange the blocks into four rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 5: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 6: Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
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
