Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 6-1/2" square for the Center Block
Trim the remainder of the strip to 4" wide, then subcut:
four 4" squares for the Center Block HSTs
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" side Border 3 strips
two 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips

From Fabric B, cut:

two 6" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 6" squares for the Border 2 HSTs
Trim the remainder of the second strip to 5-1/2" wide, then subcut:
four 5-1/2" squares for Border 2
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 4" squares for the Center Block HSTs
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares for the Center Block

From Fabric C, cut:

two 5-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eleven 5-3/4" squares. Cut each one in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles from each squares. Set aside for Border 5.
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4" squares for the Center Block HSTs
Trim the remainder of the second strip to 3-1/2" wide, then subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares for the Center Block
five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 3-1/2" x 34-1/2" side Border 4 strips
two 3-1/2" x 40-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 strips
four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the Center Block
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" side Border 6 strips
two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom Border 6 strips

From Fabric D, cut:

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. The trim:
two 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" side Border 1 strips
two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

From Fabric E, cut:

two 6" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 6" squares for the Border 2 HSTs

From Fabric F, cut:

four 5-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-two 5-3/8" squares. Cut each one in half along one diagonal, creating two triangles from each squares. Set aside for Border 5.

From Fabric G, cut:

two 5-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eleven 5-3/4" squares. Cut each one in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles from each squares. Set aside for Border 5.

From Fabric H, cut:

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5-1/2" x 52-1/2" side Border 7 strips

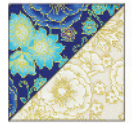
two 5-1/2" x 62-1/2" top/bottom Border 7 strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric A square with a 4" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight A/B HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1, using 4" Fabric B and Fabric C squares to make eight B/C HSTs.



Step 3: Repeat Step 1, using 6" Fabric E and 6" Fabric B squares to make sixteen 5-1/2" B/E HSTs.

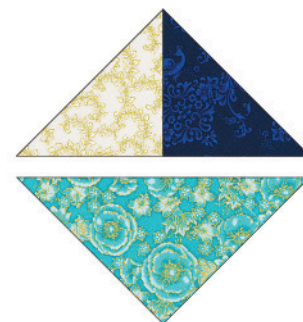


Assemble the Half Quarter-Square Triangles (Half-QSTs)

Step 4: Arrange one Fabric G small triangle and one Fabric C small triangle to form a pair, taking care to orient the fabric as shown in the example here. Sew together and press toward the darker fabric.



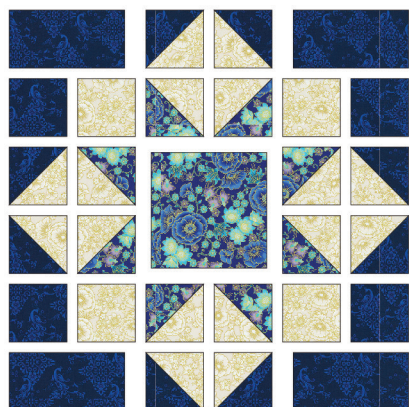
Step 5: Sew one Fabric F large triangle the long edge of the pair from the previous step. Press toward the large triangle. Trim to 4-1/2".



Step 6: Repeat Steps 4 and 5 to make forty-four Half-QSTs.



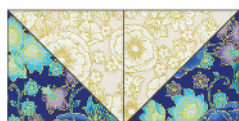
Assemble the Center Block



Step 7: Gather:
 one 6-1/2" Fabric A square
 eight A/B HSTs
 eight B/C HSTs
 four 3-1/2" Fabric B squares
 four 3-1/2" Fabric C squares
 four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C rectangles

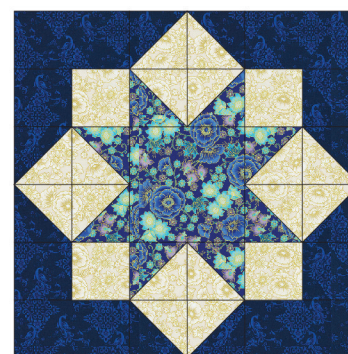
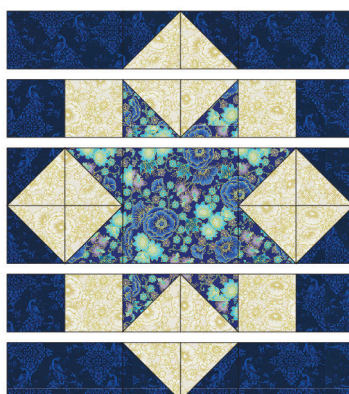
Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the HSTs together in pairs, as shown. Press the seam open.

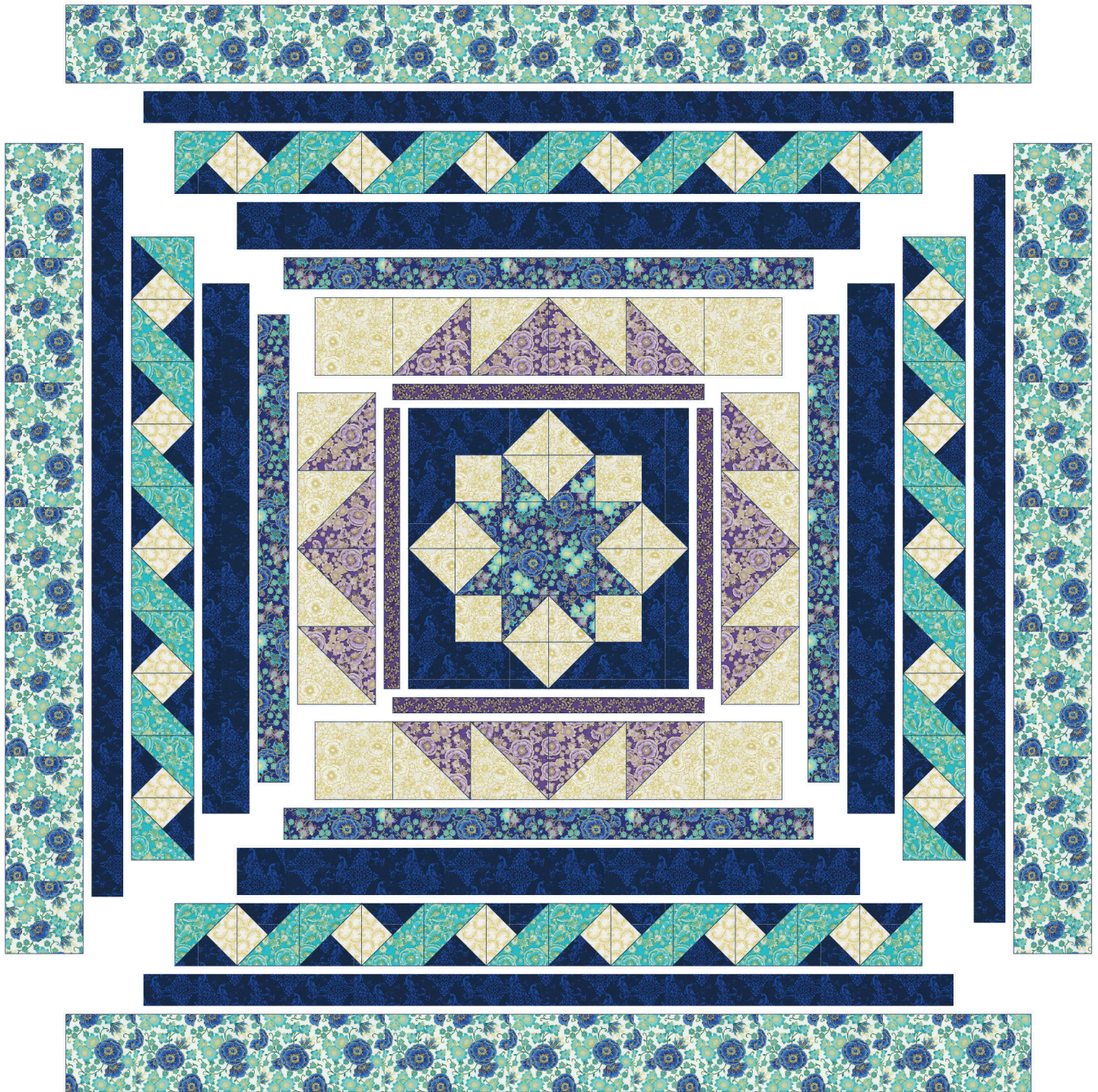


Step 9: Sew the units together to form rows, as shown. Press the seams away from the HST pairs, or open.

Step 10: Sew the rows together, pressing the seams to one side to form the Center Block, which should measure 18-1/2" square.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 11: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Gather four B/E HSTs and sew together to form the left Border 2 unit, as shown, noting the orientation of the HSTs. Press. Sew to the left edge of the quilt center and press. Repeat for the right Border 2 unit. Gather four B/E HSTs and two 5-1/2" Fabric B squares and sew together to form the top Border 2 unit, as shown, noting the orientation of the HSTs. Press. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center and press. Repeat for the bottom Border 2 unit.

Step 13: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 15: Gather ten Half-QSTs and sew together to form the left Border 5 unit, as shown, noting the orientation of the units. Press. Sew to the left edge of the quilt center and press. Repeat for the right Border 5 unit. Gather twelve Half-QSTs and sew together to form the top Border 5 unit, as shown, noting the orientation of the units. Press. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center and press. Repeat for the bottom Border 5 unit.

Step 16: Sew the side Border 6 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 6 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 17: Sew the side Border 7 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 7 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
