- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

- four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty 4-1/2" squares for the B Block HSTs five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" side Border 3 strips two 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips nineteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty 1-1/2" x 4" rectangles for the B Blocks thirty 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" side borders for the A Blocks thirty 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" top/bottom borders for the A Blocks
- five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" side Border 1 strips two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

From Fabric B, fussy cut:

eight 6-1/2" square for the A Block centers

From Fabric C, fussy cut:

seven 6-1/2" square for the A Block centers

From each of Fabrics D-H and J, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 4-1/2" squares for the B Block HSTs From the remainder of the strip, cut: two 1-1/2" squares

From each of Fabric I, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 4-1/2" squares for the B Block HSTs From the remainder of the strip, cut: two 1-1/2" squares

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" side Border 2 strips two 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 strips

From Fabric K, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 4-1/2" squares for the B Block HSTs From the remainder of the strip, cut: one 1-1/2" square

From Fabric L, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" side Border 4 strips two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks



Step 1: Gather:

two Fabric A side B Block borders two Fabric A top/bottom B Block borders one Fabric B square

Step 2: Sew the side block borders to the B square. Press the seams toward the borders.

Step 3: Sew the top/bottom block borders to the B square. Press the seams toward the borders.

The resulting A Block should measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight A Blocks with Fabric B centers, and seven A Blocks with Fabric C centers.



Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 4: Pair a 4-1/2" Fabric A square with a 4-1/2" Fabric D square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4" square. Repeat to make eight A/D HSTs.



Step 5: Repeat Step 4 to make:



Assemble the B Blocks




Step 6: Gather: four A/D HSTs one 1-1/2" Fabric D square four 1-1/2" x 4" Fabric A rectangles

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 7: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams toward the A rectangles.

Step 8: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting B Block should measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make two B Blocks from each of Fabrics D-J and one B Block from Fabric K.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 9: Arrange the A and B Blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 10: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 11: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 12: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 15: Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
