Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and B, fussy cut:

two 12-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles
two 12-1/2" x 23" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 3" x 41-1/2" strips

From Fabric A, cut:

twelve 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 3" x 41-1/2" strips

five 3" x 12-1/2" block sashing strips

Sew the remaining six strips together, then trim to make:

two 3" x 48" strips

two 3" x 63" strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt

Step 1: Arrange three Fabric A and Fabric B rectangles to form Column 1. Sew the rectangles together, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, and placing a Fabric D block sashing strip between each rectangle. Press toward the sashing.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to assemble Column 2 and Column 3, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for block sizes and placement.

Step 3: Sew Columns 1-3 together, placing a 48" Fabric D strip between each column. Press toward the strip.

Step 4: Sew a 41-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of a Fabric C strip. Press. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center and press. Repeat to make a second unit and sew to the bottom of the quilt center. Press.

Step 5: Sew a 63" Fabric D strip to the left and right edges of the quilt. Press.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
