## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From each Ten Square, select at least thirty-two squares.

Cut each selected square in half vertically and horizontally to yield 5 " squares.
Set one-hundred and nineteen of the squares aside for the half-square triangles.
Select nine of the remaining 5" squares.
Cut each selected square once diagonally to yield large triangles.

## From Fabric A, cut:

seventeen $5^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut:
one-hundred and thirty-six 5" squares.
Set one-hundred and nineteen of the squares aside for the half-square triangles.
Subcut seventeen of the 5" squares once on the diagonal to yield large triangles. One large triangle can be set aside for another project or discarded.
one 3-3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 3-3/4" squares.
Subcut each square once on the diagonal to yield small triangles.

## From Fabric B, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 74^{\prime \prime}$ inner side border strips.
two 1-1/2" x 59" inner top/bottom borders

## From Fabric C, cut:

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 4-1/2" $\times 76^{\prime \prime}$ outer side border strips.
two 4-1/2" x 67" outer top/bottom border strips.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a 5" square cut from a ten square, RST.
Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 using the remaining 5" Fabric A squares paired with the remaining squares cut from the ten squares to make a total of two-hundred and thirty-eight HSTs.


Step 3: Arrange the blocks into diagonal rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Add a small Fabric A triangle to each corner of the quilt top. Add a large Fabric A triangle to the upper end and the right and/or left edge of each row. Add triangle cut from a ten square to the bottom edge of each row. Pay attention to the rotation of the HSTs and triangles in the diagram.

Step 4: Sew the blocks together to form diagonal rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

Step 5: Sew the diagonal rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.


Step 6: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
