## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From the Ten Square Pack, cut:

thirty $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## From Fabric A, cut:

thirty $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side block borders
sixty $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom block borders
seventy-one 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
From Fabric B , cut:
seventeen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
eighty-two 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles
From Fabric C, cut:
six $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders
two 2" $\times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders
From Fabric D, cut:
seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" $\times 65-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
two 4-1/2" $\times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom outer borders
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks


Step 1: Gather:
one 4-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from the Ten Square Pack two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips

Step 2: Sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips to the left and right edges of the center rectangle. Press. Sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips to the top and bottom edges of the center rectangle. Press.

The resulting Block should measure $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat with all of the Ten Square rectangles for a total of thirty Blocks.


Step 3: Gather:
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric B rectangles
one $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle
Sew the Fabric B rectangles to opposite edges of the Fabric A rectangle, as shown. Press.

The resulting Sashing Unit should measure $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make a total of thirty-five Sashing Units.

## Assemble the Sashing Rows

Step 4: Gather:
two 2-1/2" $\times 5$ " Fabric B rectangles
five $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangles
six $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles
Sew the Sashing Row together, as shown. Note that the shorter B rectangles are on the extreme left and right ends of the row. Press.
$\square$
Repeat to make a total of six Sashing Rows.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Sashing Units between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five block rows.

Step 6: Sew the sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.
Step 7: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.


Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
