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Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From the Ten Square Pack:

Cut each square into two 5" strips.

Select forty-six strips to use as long rectangles.

Cut at least thirty-two strips into sixty-four 4-3/4" x 5" rectangles.

Any remaining strips can be set aside.

From Fabric A, cut:

thirty-six 1-1/2" x WOF strips.
Sew twenty-four strips together end-to-end, then subcut: fourteen 1-1/2" x 62-1/2" sashing strips two 1-1/2" x 73" side borders
From twelve strips and the remainder of the long strip, subcut: ninety-seven 1-1/2" x 5" rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Step 1: Arrange the rectangles in rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Place a 1-1/2" x 5" Fabric A rectangle in between each rectangle, then sew the rows together. Press towards the Fabric A rectangles.

Step 2: Place a 1-1/2" x 62-1/2" Fabric A sashing strip in between the rows and at the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew the rows and sashing strips together and press the seams towards the sashing strips.

Step 3: Sew a

1-1/2" x 73" Fabric A border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seams towards the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!



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
