Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" block centers

From Fabric B, cut:

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" block borders

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 67" side strips for Border 4

two 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom strips for Border 4

two 2-1/2" x 2" rectangles for Border 5

two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

From Fabric C, cut:

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" block borders

From Fabric D, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 47-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 strips

two 4-1/2" x 55" top/bottom Border 5 strips

two 4-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

two 4-1/2" x 3" rectangles for Border 5

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 7" rectangles for Border 5

five 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3" x 56" side Border 3 strips

two 3" x 36-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips

four 3" squares for Border 3

two 3" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

thirteen 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

eight 2" x 12-1/2" block sashing strips

three 2" x 33-1/2" row sashing strips

two 2" x 53" side Border 1 units

two 2" x 36-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 units

two 2" x 61-1/2" side Border 5 strips

two 2" x 3" rectangles for Border 5

two 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

two 1-1/2" squares for Border 5

From Fabric E, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

- two 1-1/2" x 56" side Border 2 units
- two 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 units
- four 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles for Border 3
- two 1-1/2" x 2" rectangles for Border 5
- six 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles for Border 5
- two 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles for Border 5

From Fabric F, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- three 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

seven 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

- two 5-1/2" x 75" side Border 6 units
- two 5-1/2" x 68-1/2" top/bottom Border 6 units

From Fabric G, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- three 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Sew a Fabric B block border strip to the left and right edges of all Fabric A block centers. Press. Sew a Fabric B block border strip to the top and bottom edges of all Fabric A block centers. Press.

The resulting blocks should measure 10-1/2" x 12-1/2".



Step 2: Sew a Fabric C block border strip to the left and right edges of all 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric G and Fabric F block centers. Press. Sew a Fabric C block border strip to the top and bottom edges of all Fabric G and G block centers. Press.

The resulting blocks should measure 10-1/2" x 12-1/2".

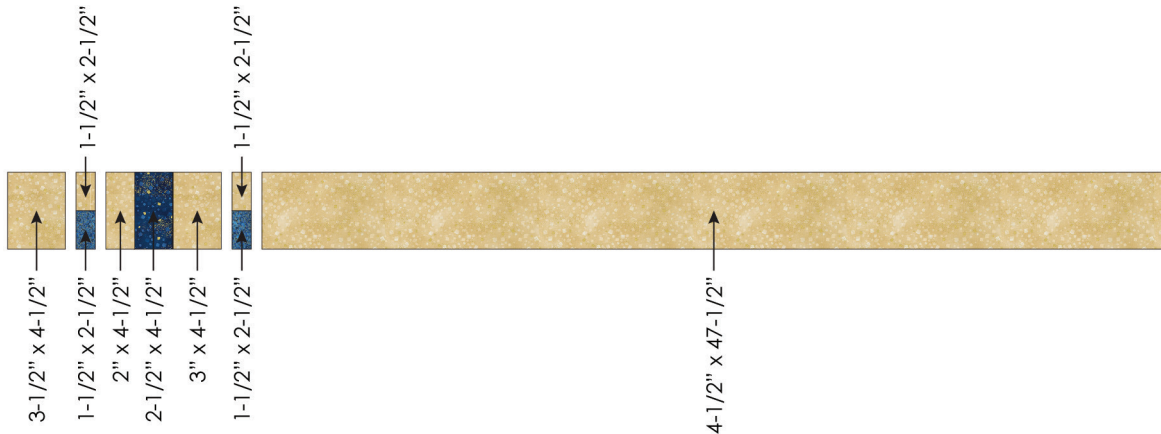


Assemble the Borders

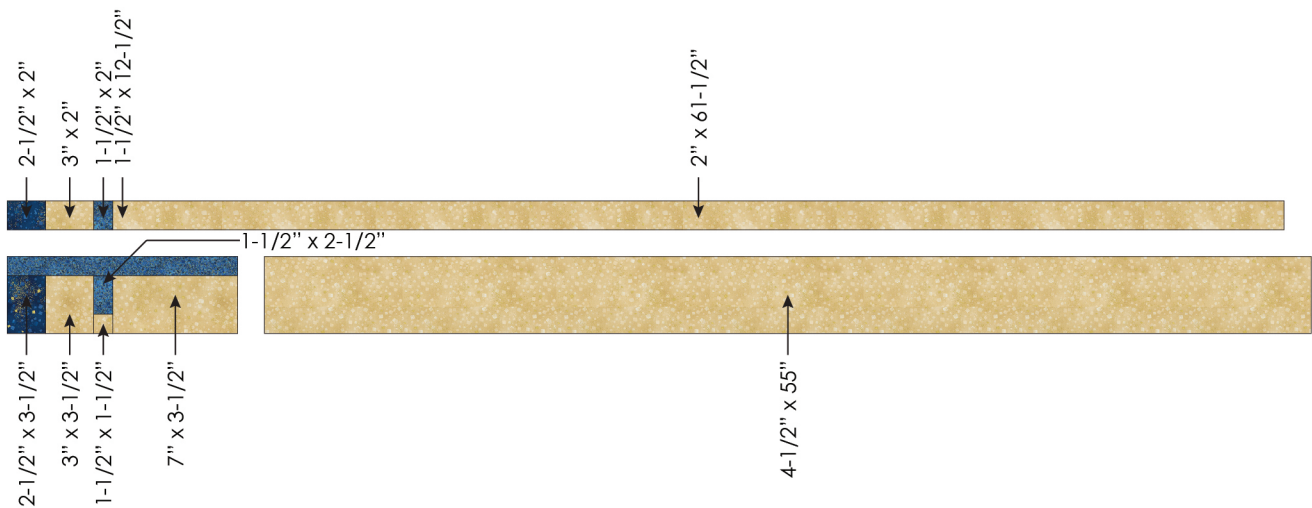
Step 3: Sew a 1-1/2" x 3" Fabric E rectangle to opposite ends of a 3" x 36-1/2" Fabric D strip. Press. Sew a 3" Fabric D square to opposite ends of a the strip. Press. Repeat to make a second strip like this. This is the top/bottom Border 3 unit.



Step 4: Sew the Fabric D, E and B units together, as shown. Press. Repeat to make a second unit like this. This is the top/bottom Border 5 unit.



Step 5: Sew the Fabric D, E and B units together, as shown. Press. Repeat to make a second unit like this. This is the side Border 5 unit.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 6: Arrange the A, G and F Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Fabric D sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

Step 7: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 8: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the top/bottom Border 2 pieces to the top/bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top/bottom Border 3 pieces to the top/bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the side Border 5 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 5 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
