## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From the Ten Square Pack:

Select at least thirty squares. All squares can be used for added variety.
From the selected squares, cut:
two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 4-1/2" squares from each strip. Subcut each square in half once diagonally.
Note: A total of two-hundred and forty triangles are needed.

## From Fabric A, cut:

seventeen 2" x WOF strips.
From six of the strips, subcut:
twenty-four 2" x 8-1/2" vertical sashing strips.
Sew the remaining eleven strips together end-to-end, then subcut: seven 2" $\times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal sashing strips. two 2 " $\times 59$ " side inner borders.

## From Fabric B, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 4-1/2" $\times 59^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders.
two 4-1/2" $\times 57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom outer borders.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Make the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Tip: The longest edges of the triangles are a bias edges. Handle the triangles carefully to prevent stretching.

Step 1: Select two triangles and lay them RST. Sew along the longest edge of the triangles, then press towards the darker fabric.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make one-hundred and twenty half-square triangles. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on page 4 for fabric combinations.

Assemble the Blocks

Step 3: Select four half-square triangles featuring a variety of fabrics. Arrange the half-square triangles in two rows of two as shown.


Step 4: Sew the half-square triangles together to form rows and press the seams in opposite directions.

Step 5: Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seam open or to
 one side. The block should measure 8-1/2" square.
Step 6: Repeat Steps 3-5 to make thirty blocks.
Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on page 4 for fabric combinations.


Step 7: Arrange the blocks in six rows of five blocks as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Place a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip in between each of the blocks, then sew the rows together. Press towards the sashing strips.

Step 8: Place a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip between the rows and at the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew the rows and sashing strips together and press the seams towards the sashing strips.

Step 9: Sew a 2 " $\times 59$ " Fabric A border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seams towards the borders.

Step 10: Sew a $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 59^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seams towards the borders. Sew a 4-1/2" x 57-1/2" Fabric B border to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams towards the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
