Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Tip: Layer Fabric A and Fabric D strips opened, right sides together to cut triangles. They will then be ready to chain-sew.

From Fabric A, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty Half-Square Triangles fifteen 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

four 4" x WOF strips. Set aside for the borders.

From Fabric C, cut**:

three 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fifteen 6-1/2" squares **fussy cut the strips, and then the squares, so that you have four boxes in each 6-1/2" square

From Fabric D, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty Half-Square Triangles sixty 2-1/2" squares


From the Binding Fabric, cut:

170" of bias cut binding, cut 2-1/4" wide


Assembling the Blocks

Step 1 Sew all the Fabric A and Fabric D triangles together. Press toward the Fabric A triangles. At this point the triangle-squares should measure 2-1/2" square. Make sixty.





Step 2 Join four white squares, four triangle-squares and a Fabric A square to make a star block as shown. Follow the pressing directions. Make fifteen blocks. At this point the blocks should measure 6-1/2" square.



Assembling the Quilt



Step 1 Using the Quilt Assembly Diagram as a guide, lay out the blocks in rows, alternating Fabric C squares with completed Step 2 blocks. Sew the blocks together in rows, pressing toward the Fabric C squares.

Step 2 Sew the rows together, matching and pinning seams. Press the row seams all one direction.

Step 3 Measure and trim two borders the width of the quilt. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Step 4 Measure and trim two borders the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
