Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-J, cut:

one 8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 8" squares, then cut each square in half along one diagonal.

From Fabric K, cut:

four 21-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 21-1/2" squares

Trim the remainder of each strip to 15", then subcut:

four 15" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal.

one 14-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 14-1/2" square

one 8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 8" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal.

seven 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3" x 70-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

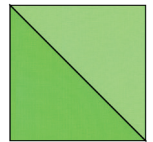
two 3" x 75-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair the 8" triangles together, using the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric pairings, or choose pairings to your liking. Note that eight of the pairs will be with Fabric K, and that fourteen triangles will not be used for a full HST. Sew the triangles together to form the HSTs, pressing the seam to one side. Trim all HSTs to 7-1/2" square, centering the seam through the diagonal. You will have thirty-six HSTs, and fourteen single triangles remaining.



Step 2: Gather:

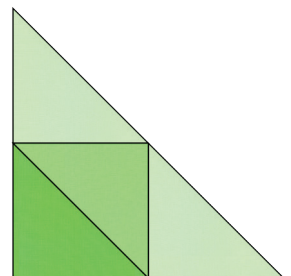
one 15" Fabric K triangle

two different-colored green triangles

one HST

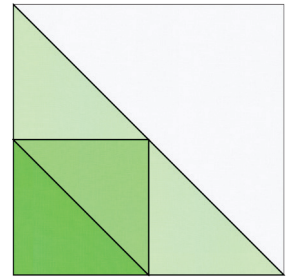
(Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for exact HST and print triangle fabrics)

Sew the green triangles to two adjacent edges of the HST, as shown, aligning the 90-degree angles of the triangle with the corner of the HST. Press. Trim the long edge, if needed, ensuring that 1/4" of fabric extends beyond the point where the seams meet the corner of the HST.



Sew the 15" Fabric K triangle to the long edge of the unit. Press. Trim to 14-1/2" square, if needed.

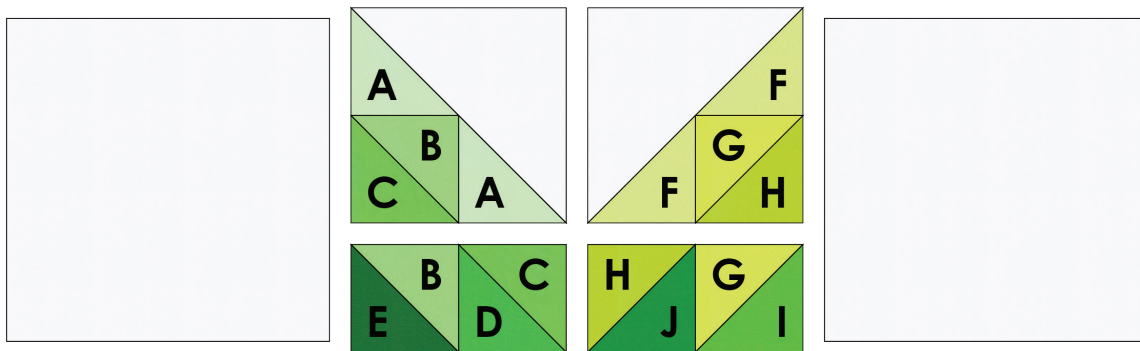
Repeat to make a total of eight units like this, referring to the Quilt Section Diagrams for fabric placement.



Assemble the Sections

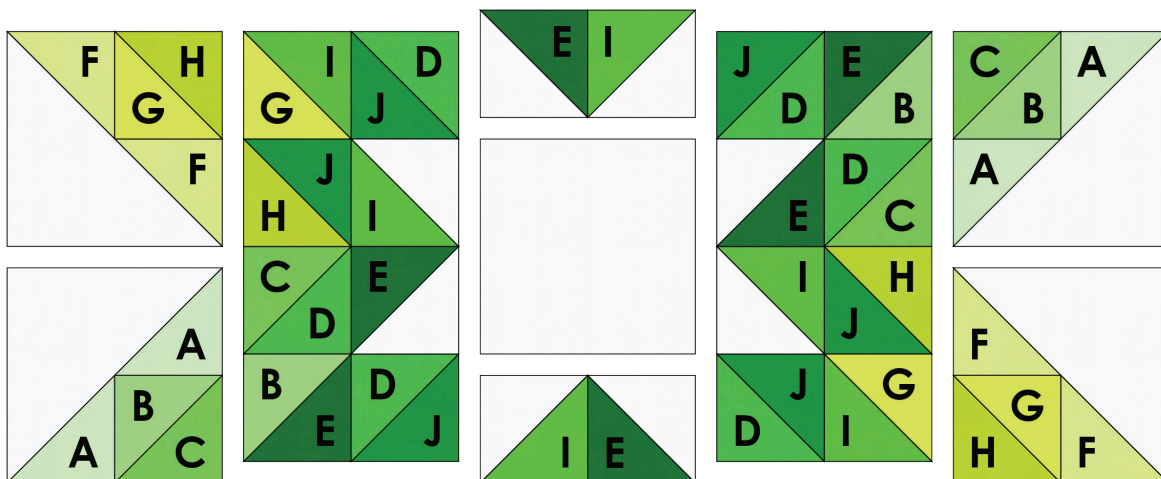
Step 3: Gather:
 two 21-1/2" Fabric K squares
 two Step 2 units
 four HSTs
 (Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for exact fabrics)

Arrange as shown to form Section 1, the top row. Sew together as shown, and press.



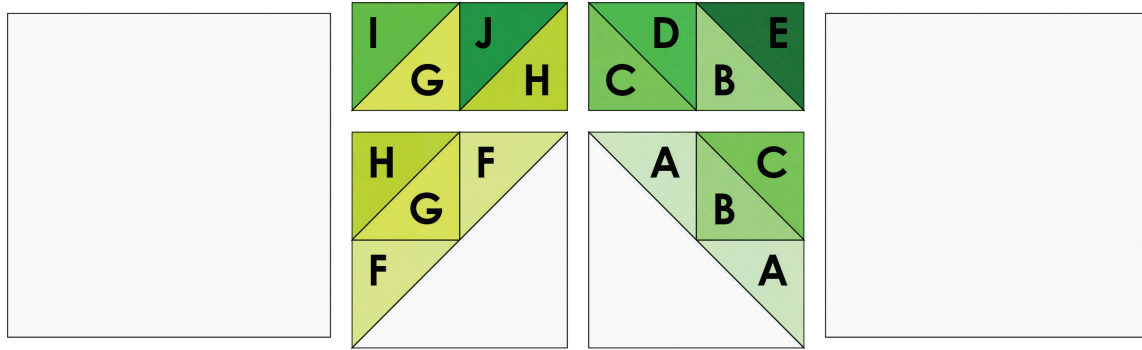
Step 4: Gather:
 one 14-1/2" Fabric K square
 four Step 2 units
 twenty HSTs
 (Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for exact fabrics)

Arrange as shown to form Section 2, the center row. Sew together as shown, and press.

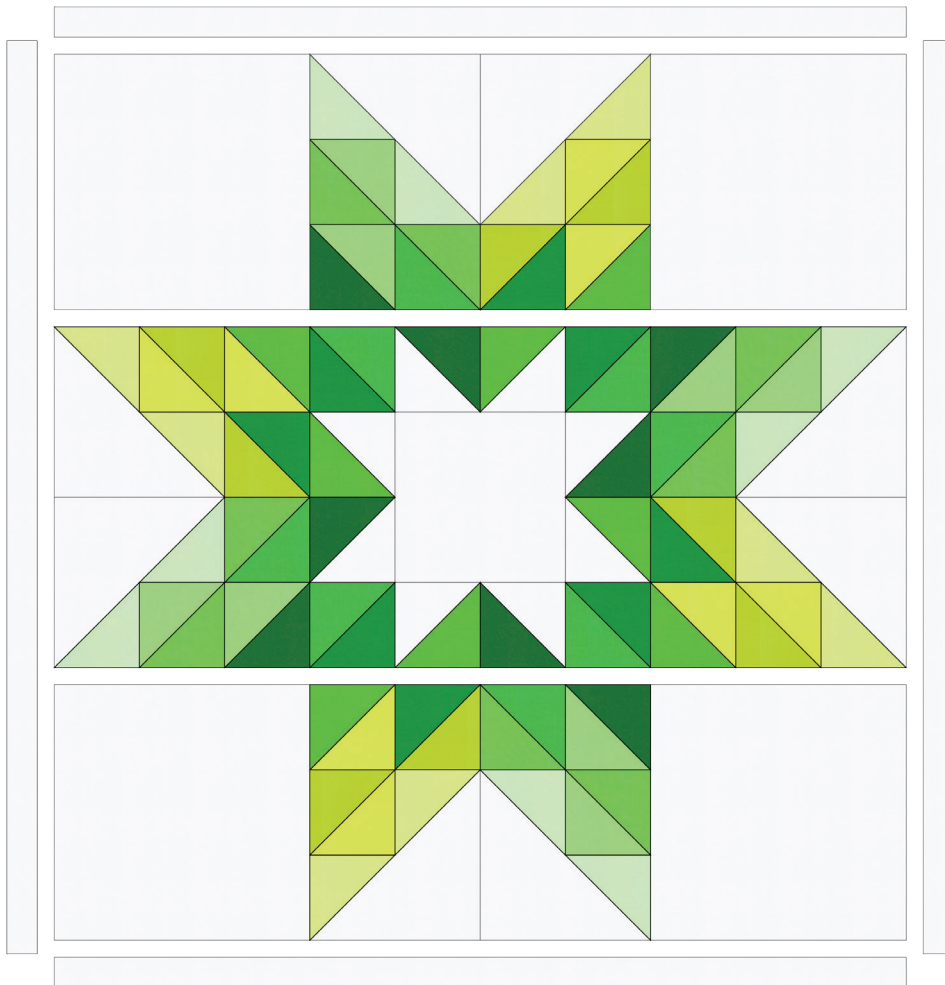


Step 5: Gather:
 two 21-1/2" Fabric K squares
 two Step 2 units
 four HSTs
 (Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for exact fabrics)

Arrange as shown to form Section 3, the bottom row. Sew together as shown, and press.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 6: Sew Section 1 and 3 to the top and bottom edges of Section 2, as shown. Press.

Step 7: Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete!
 Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
