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### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

# **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

eleven x 5" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighty-four 5 squares.

#### From each of Fabrics B-H, cut:

two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 5" squares.

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a 5" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the

marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty-four A/B HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make the quantities and fabric combinations shown below.



Make twenty-four A/C HSTs.

Make twenty-four A/D HSTs.



Make twenty-four A/F HSTs. Make twenty-four A/G HSTs. Make twenty-four

A/E HSTs.



Make twenty-four A/H HSTs.

Assemble the Quilt



**Step 3:** Arrange the HSTs into fourteen rows of twelve. Note the fabric placement and HST orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 4:** Sew the HSTs together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

Step 5: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
