

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A

- Cut panel to 23-1/2" x 43-1/2".

Fabric B

- Cut four strips 1-1/2" x WOF.

Fabric C

- Cut two strips 1-1/2" x WOF.

Fabric D

- Cut four strips 4" x WOF.
- Cut one strip 7-1/2" x WOF.

Fabric E

- Cut four strips 4" x WOF.
- Cut one strip 10-1/2" x WOF, then subcut into:
 - One rectangle 10-1/2" x 13".
 - Two squares 10-1/2" x 10-1/2".

Fabric F

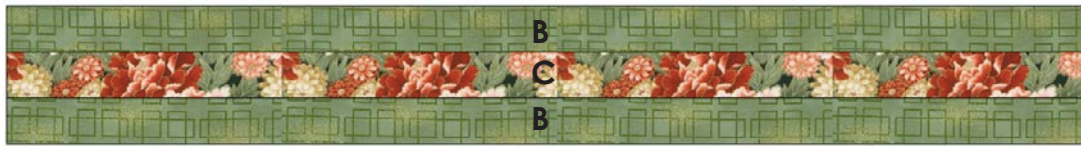
- Cut two strips 2" x 10-1/2".

Fabric G

- Cut two strips 1-1/2" x 10-1/2".

Assembly Instructions

- Sew two Fabric B strips to the long sides of one Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second Strip Set B/C/B.

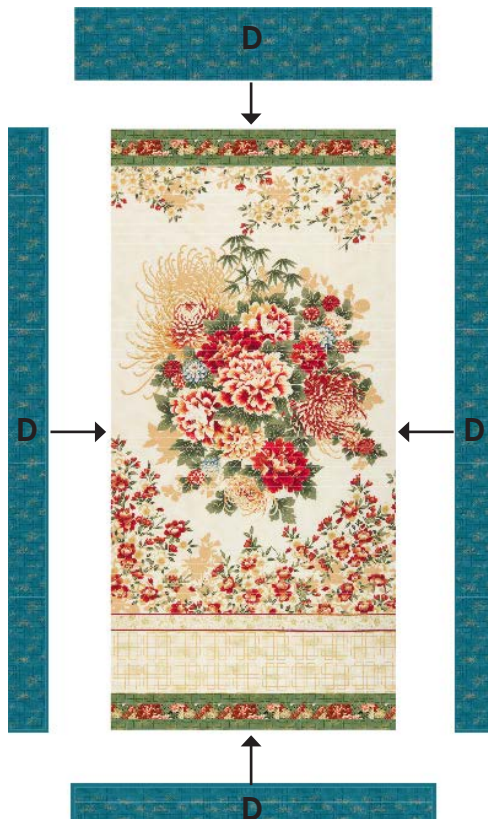


Make two sets

- Sew Strip Sets B/C/B to the short sides of Panel A. Trim excess fabric from the ends of the strip sets so they are even with Panel A.

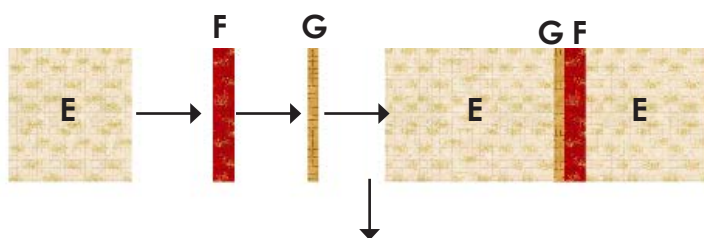


Tip: It is important to lay your pieces flat on a table and pin them together before sewing. This will keep long borders from warping and stretching as you sew them on to your quilt top.



- Sew three Fabric D 4" strips end to end to create one long strip. Cut strip in half and sew the two lengths to each long side of the quilt top. Trim excess strips to true up to quilt top.
- Sew the remaining Fabric D 4" strip to the bottom of the quilt top. Trim excess to true up.
- Sew the Fabric D 7-1/2" strip to the top of the quilt top. Trim excess to true up.

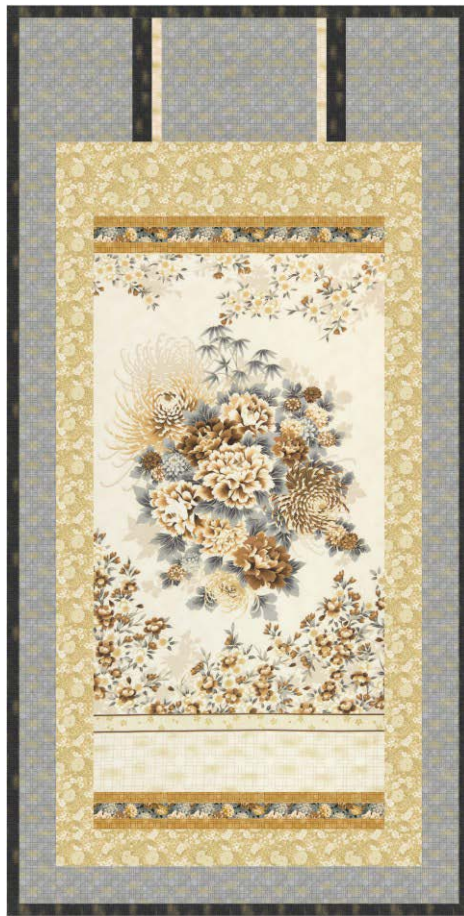
- Sew three Fabric E 4" strips end to end to create one long strip. Cut strip in half and sew the two lengths to each long side of the quilt top. Trim excess strips to true up to quilt top.
- Sew remaining Fabric E 4" strip to the bottom of the quilt top. Trim excess to true up.










- Sew the Fabric G strips to each short side of the Fabric E rectangle, then sew the Fabric F strips to the remaining long sides of the the Fabric G strips.
- Sew the Fabric E squares to either long side of the Fabric F strips.
- Sew this border unit to the top of the quilt top.

Your quilt top is complete.
Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
