
Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From the Ten Square pack:

Choose two squares each from sixteen prints (for a total of thirty-two squares). From the first set of sixteen squares, cut:



one 6" square two 3" squares two strips 1-1/2" x 10" From each of the second set of sixteen squares:

choose five prints for the inner pieced border choose six prints for the outer pieced border



From each of these, cut:
four 2-1/2" x 10" rectangles
(you will have five remaining squares from the set that will be unused)

From Fabric U, cut:

eleven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 2-1/2" squares

sixty-four 2-1/2" x 6" rectangles

Trim the remainder of the last strip to 1-1/2" wide, then subcut:

nine 1-1/2" squares

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-two 3" squares

six 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-1/4" x 52" side middle borders

two 3-1/4" x 57-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

five 3-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-3/4" x 41-1/2" side inner borders

two 3-3/4" x 48" top/bottom inner borders

seven 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3" x 67-1/2" side outer borders

two 3" x 72-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From Fabric V, cut:

seven 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3" x 67-1/2" side outer borders

two 3" x 72-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/4" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Pair a 3" print square with a 3" Fabric U square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixteen sets of four HSTs.



Step 2: Gather:

four matching 2-1/2" HSTs one matching 6" square four 2-1/2" x 6" Fabric U rectangles

Arrange in three rows of three, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together to form rows, pressing the seams away from the Fabric U rectangles. Sew the rows together to form the block, pressing the seams open or to one side. The resulting block should measure 10" square.



Repeat to make a total of sixteen blocks.

Assemble the Quilt Center



Step 3: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using 1-1/2" x 10" sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

Step 4: Gather three 1-1/2"
Fabric U cornerstone
squares and four 1-1/2"
x 10" sashing strips. Sew
each row together, using
cornerstones between
each sashing strip. Press
seams toward the sashing.
Repeat to make three
sashing rows.

Step 5: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.



Step 6: Sew the 3-3/4" x 41-1/2" Fabric U side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 3-3/4" x 48" Fabric U top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew five 2-1/2" x 10" inner pieced border strips together. Repeat to make a total of four inner pieced borders. Sew one to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press. Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric U square to each end of the remaining inner pieced borders. Sew these borders to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.

Step 8: Sew the 3-1/4" x 52" Fabric U side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 3-1/4" x 57-1/2" Fabric U top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew six 2-1/2" x 10" outer pieced border strips together. Repeat to make a total of four outer pieced borders. Sew one to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press. Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric U square to each end of the remaining outer pieced borders. Sew these borders to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.

Step 10: Sew the 3-1/2" \times 61-1/2" Fabric U side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 3-1/2" \times 67-1/2" Fabric U top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the 3" \times 67-1/2" Fabric V side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 3" \times 72-1/2" Fabric V top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
