Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 43" wide.

3-1/3 yards for backing

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

- six 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - eighty 3" squares for the HSTs
- eleven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - twenty-five 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" block sashing strips
 - eighty 2-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics B-F , H and I, cut:

- two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - twenty 3" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric G, cut:

- six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
 - two 4-1/2" x 62-1/2" side outer borders
 - two 4-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
- two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - twenty 3" squares for the HSTs

From each of Fabrics J-L, cut:

- two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to 42-1/2" long and set aside for the row sashing strips.

From Fabric M, cut:

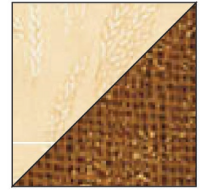
- five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
 - two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" side inner borders
 - two 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

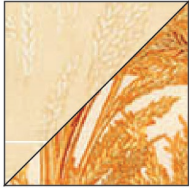
- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

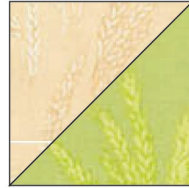
Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty A/B HSTs.



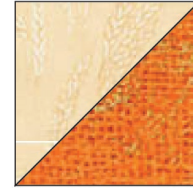
Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:



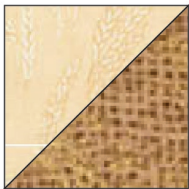
twenty A/C HSTs



twenty A/D HSTs



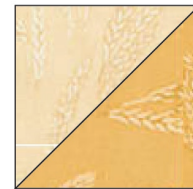
twenty A/E HSTs

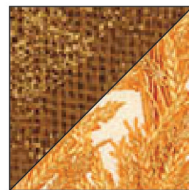

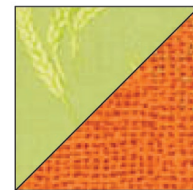
twenty A/H HSTs

Assemble the Blocks



Step 3: Gather:

four 2-1/2" Fabric A squares
one of each combination of HST (twelve different HSTs)

Arrange the units into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

Step 5: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The block will measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 3-5 to make a total of twenty Blocks.

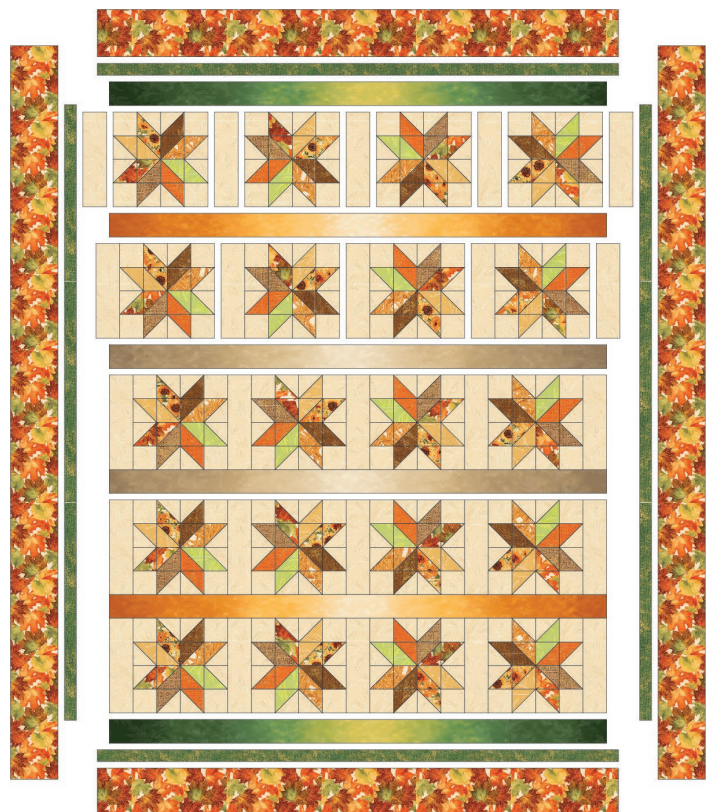
Assemble the Quilt

Step 6: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, noting the different orientations in the quilt. Sew each row together, using Fabric A sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five block rows.

Step 7: Sew the sashing and block rows together, noting the placement of Fabrics J-L. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 8: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
