

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

yards for backing

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Length of fabric has been abbreviated to LOF.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

three 17-1/2" x 17-1/2" squares centered over the motifs

From Fabric B, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF, sew end to end and subcut:
two 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" top and bottom borders
two 2-1/2" x 27-1/2" side borders

seven 1-1/2" x WOF

From Fabric C, cut:

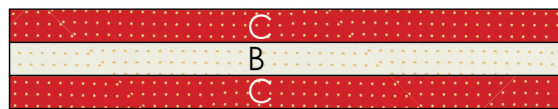
eleven 1-1/2" x WOF

From Binding Fabric, cut:

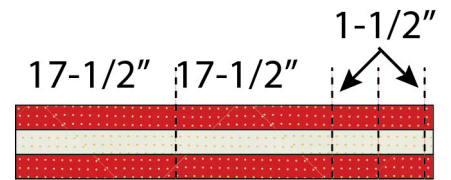
five 2-1/2" x WOF

Assemble the Blocks

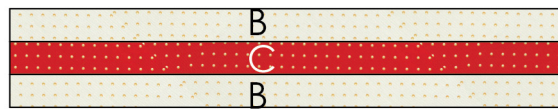
Step 1: Gather one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip, and two 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips. Sew the strips together with the Fabric B strip in the center. Press towards Fabric C. Repeat to make five strip sets.



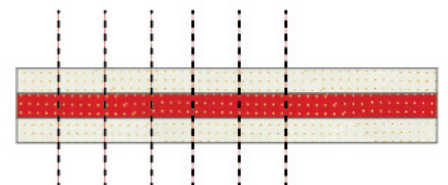
Step 2: Subcut the strip sets into ten 3-1/2" x 17-1/2" rectangles and eight 3-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles.



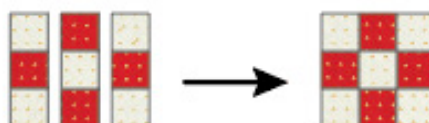
Step 3: Gather two 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips, and one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric C strip. Sew the strips together with the Fabric C strip in the center. Press towards Fabric C.



Step 4: Subcut the strip sets into sixteen 3-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles.



Step 5: Sew two Fabric B/C/B rectangles on either side of a Fabric C/B/C rectangle to make a nine patch. Repeat to make eight nine patch units.

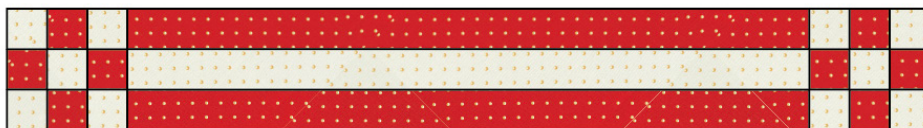


Step 6: Gather one 17-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabric A square and two 3-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabrics C/B/C rectangle. Sew a rectangle on the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Press towards Fabric C.

Repeat for the remaining two Fabric A squares.



Step 7: Gather one 3-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabrics C/B/C rectangle and two nine patch squares. Sew one nine patch on both ends of the C/B/C rectangle to make the vertical sashing strip. Press towards the rectangle.



Step 8: Layout table runner as desired. Sew a vertical sashing strip between each motif and on the ends. Press towards Fabric C.



Step 9: Sew the top and bottom border. Press towards the border. Sew the side borders. Press towards the border.



Step 10: Quilt and bind as desired.
