# Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

#### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

one strip 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut two 4-1/2" squares one strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut two 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric B, cut:

one strip 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut four 4-1/2" squares one strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut four 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric C, cut:

two strips 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut six 4-1/2" squares one strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut six 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric D, cut:

one strip 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut eight 4-1/2" squares one strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut eight 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric E, cut:

two strips 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut ten 4-1/2" squares one strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut ten 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric F, cut:

two strips 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut twelve 4-1/2" squares one strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut twelve 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric G, cut:

two strips 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut fourteen 4-1/2" squares two strip 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut fourteen 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric H, cut:

seven strips 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut fifty-six 4-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric I, cut:

five strips 3-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut fifty-six 3-1/2" squares

\*\*Cut all of the squares from Fabrics A-I along one diagonal.



#### From Fabric J, fussy cut:

twenty-eight 3-1/2" light background squares twenty-eight 3-1/2" colorful background squares


#### From Fabric K, cut:


five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

## **Block Assembly**

#### Assembly using the colorful-background panel squares:

**Step 1:** Onto each Fabric J colorful panel square, sew a Fabric I triangle onto one edge.






**Step 2:** Sew a Fabric I triangle onto the opposite edge.

**Step 3:** Press the seams and trim the "dog ears" to help prevent bulk.





**Step 4:** Sew a Fabric I triangle onto the remaining two edges and press.

**Step 5:** Trim the square to 4-3/4," making sure to leave a 1/4" seam allowance between the points of the center square and each edge.

**Step 6:** To make the Fabric A block, select one of the squares from Step 5 and sew a 4-1/2" Fabric A triangle onto each edge as shown in steps 1-4.


**Step 7:** Trim the square to 6-1/2," making sure to leave a 1/4" seam allowance between the outer points of the Fabric I triangles and each edge.



**Step 8:** Repeat to make two Fabric B blocks, three Fabric C blocks, four Fabric D blocks, five Fabric E blocks, six Fabric F blocks, and seven Fabric G blocks.

#### Assembly using the white-background panel squares:


**Step 9:** To make the Fabric A square, sew a 3-1/2" fabric A triangle onto each side as shown in Steps 1-5.



**Step 10:** Repeat to make two Fabric B blocks, three Fabric C blocks, four Fabric D blocks, five Fabric E blocks, six Fabric F blocks, and seven Fabric G blocks.

**Step 11:** Onto each of the blocks from Steps 9-10, sew a Fabric H triangle onto each side as described in Steps 1-4.

**Step 12:** Trim each block to 6-1/2" square, making sure to leave a 1/4" seam allowance between the outer points of the colorful triangles and each edge.



## Quilt Assembly



**Step 13:** Arrange the blocks as shown in the quilt layout diagram.

**Step 14:** Sew the blocks into rows. Press toward the colorful panel blocks.

**Step 15:** Sew the rows together. Press the seams open or to one side.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt bind and enjoy!
