Finished quilt measures: $45^{\prime \prime} \times 45^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

four $15-1 / 2$ " squares so that a motif is in the center of each square

## From each of Fabrics B-E, cut:

two 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 2 " x 15-1/2" rectangles of each fabric
two 2 " $\times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of each fabric

## From Fabric F , cut:

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
$1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom middle borders
$1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side middle borders

## From Fabric G, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 2-1/2" $\times 41-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
Sew the three remaining strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
six 1-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" top/bottom inner borders
two 1-1/2" $\times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders
one 1-1/2" $\times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal sashing strip
two 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" vertical sashing strips
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks
Step 1: Gather one 15-1/2" Fabric A square, two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangles, and two 2 " $\times 18$ - $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangles. Sew the two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the sides of the square, then press towards the rectangles. Sew the two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom of the unit, then press towards the rectangles.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make three additional blocks using matching rectangles of Fabrics C-E for each block.

Step 3: Arrange the blocks into two rows of two blocks. Note the fabric placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Place a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ vertical sashing strip in between each of the blocks. Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the evennumbered rows.

Step 5: Place the 1-1/2" x 37-1/2" horizontal sashing strip between the rows. Sew the rows together

to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 6: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
