## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

five 6-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-six 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
twenty-six 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
five $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-six 2-1/2" squares

## From Fabric B, cut:

eleven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one hundred seventy-six 2-1/2" squares
seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" x 64-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 strips
two 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" side Border 2 strips

From Fabric C, cut:
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-nine 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-two 2-1/2" squares
Sew the remainder of the strip to the six full strips, together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips
two 2-1/2" $\times 66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 1 strips

## From Fabric E, cut:

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" x 72-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips
two 4-1/2" $\times 72-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 3 strips
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-two 2-1/2" squares
From Fabric F, cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-four 2-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics $\mathbf{G}$ and $\mathbf{N}$, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 2-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics H, I, J, and L, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-two 2-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics K, M and P, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-two 2-1/2" squares
From Fabric O, cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty 2-1/2" squares
From each of Fabrics $Q, R$, and $T$, cut:
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
ten 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric $S$, cut:
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" squares
From Fabric U, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 2-1/2" squares
From Fabric V, cut:
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twelve 2-1/2" squares
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Block 1 Units



Step 1: Gather:
two $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles two 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles
four Fabric B squares
two Fabric A squares
one Fabric C square
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit, pressing all seams

## Assemble the Block 2 Units



Step 2: Gather 2-1/2" squares in the Fabrics indicated.
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit, first sewing together to form rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row, then nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press all seams down.

Repeat to make a total of twelve Block 2 units.


## Assemble the Block 3 Units

Step 3: Gather 2-1/2" squares in the Fabrics indicated.
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit. Press the seams up.
Repeat to make a total of ten Block 3 units.

## Assemble the Block 4 Units

Step 4: Gather 2-1/2" squares in the Fabrics indicated.
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit. Press the seams up.
Repeat to make a total of ten Block 4 units.

## Assemble the Block 5 Units



Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit, first sewing

Repeat to make a total of ten Block 5 units.

## Assemble the Block 6 Units



Step 6: Gather 2-1/2" squares in the Fabrics indicated
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit, first sewing together to form two rows. Press the seams in opposite
 directions, then nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press all seams up.

Repeat to make a total of ten Block 6 units.

## Assemble the Block 7 Units

Step 7: Gather 2-1/2" squares in the Fabrics indicated.
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit. Press all seams down.
Repeat to make a total of eight Block 7 units.

## Assemble the Block 8 Units

Step 8: Gather 2-1/2" squares in the Fabrics indicated.
Arrange as shown and sew together to form the unit. Press all seams down.


Repeat to make a total of eight Block 8 units.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 9: Arrange the units together, as indicated. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 10: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

Step 11: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the quilt center.

Step 12: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!


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
