

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

two 15-1/2" squares centered on the motifs in the panel

### From Fabric B, cut:

one 20-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 20-1/2" squares

four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 3" x 20-1/2" rectangles

four 3" x 15-1/2" rectangles

## Assemble the Pillow Front

**Step 1:** Sew a 15-1/2" Fabric A square between two 3" x 15-1/2" Fabric B rectangles. Press the seams toward the rectangles.





**Step 2:** Sew a 3" x 20-1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the unit. Press the seams toward the rectangles to complete the Pillow Front.

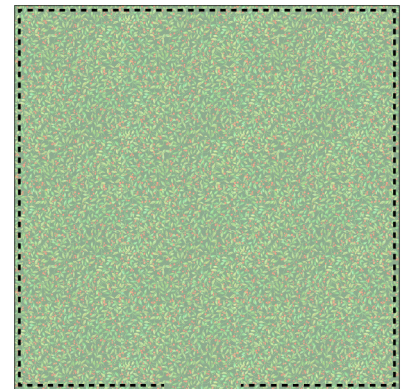


**Step 3:** Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a second Pillow Front.



## Assemble the Pillow

**Step 4:** Place a Pillow Front and a 20-1/2" Fabric B square right sides together. Sew around the perimeter, leaving a 4" opening for turning and backstitching at each end of the seam.



**Step 5:** Turn the pillow right side out through the opening. Press the edge of the pillow flat if desired.



**Step 6:** Stuff the pillow with polyester fiberfill.

**Step 7:** Whipstitch the opening closed.



**Step 8:** Repeat Steps 4-7 to make the second pillow.
