

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
ten 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles
fourteen 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
four 3-1/2" squares
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles
twelve 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 6-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 6-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles twelve 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

twelve 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: ninety-six 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: seventeen 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric G, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim: two 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" side inner borders two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" side top/bottom borders

From Fabric H, cut:

seven 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim: two 6-1/2" x 70-1/2" side outer borders two 6-1/2" x 64-1/2" top/bottom borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips


Assemble the Flying Geese

Step 1: Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric E square with a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square. Sew on the marked line. Cut the excess fabric away, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to add a second square to the opposite side of the rectangle. Repeat to make fourteen flying geese.



Assemble the Sashing Rectangles

Step 2: Place a 3-1/2" Fabric E square on two opposite corners of a 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric F rectangle, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square. Sew on the marked lines. Cut the excess fabric away, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat to add squares to the two remaining corners of the rectangle. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make seventeen sashing rectangles.




Assemble the Blocks

Step 3: Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to opposite sides of a 6-1/2" Fabric B square. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric.



Step 4: Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the sides of the unit. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew a 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make six blocks.





Step 5: Arrange the 3-1/2" Fabric A squares, 6-1/2" Fabric C squares, Flying Geese, Sashing Rectangles, and blocks in rows as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together. Press toward the sashing.

- **Step 6:** Sew the rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press the seams open or to the sashing.
- **Step 7:** Sew the inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Sew the inner borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the border.
- **Step 8:** Sew the outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Sew the outer borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the border.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
