

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Before cutting the elephant fabric, plan where you are cutting your pieces, then fussy cut them. The three A blocks feature two elephants facing each other. The two B blocks have two elephants -one on top of the other, and each of the C blocks has one elephant.

From Fabric A(elephant fabric), cut:

- Three 8-1/2" X 12" A blocks
- Two 10-1/2" x 6-1/2" B blocks
- Three 6" x 7" C blocks

From Fabric B, cut:

- One 6-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip E
- Five 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Using three strips, trim selvages and sew together into one long strip. From this strip cut two - 2-1/2" x 51" strips for D1 and D2.

From remaining two strips, cut one - 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strip J, one - 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip L, one - 2-1/2" x 11-1/2 strip M, one - 2-1/2" x 13" N and two -2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips Q & S.

• Two- 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut one - 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip K and one - 3-1/2" x 16" strip H, one - 3-1/2" x 30-1/2" strip G.

• One - 3" x WOF strip.

Sub cut one - 3" x 15-1/2" strip V. Trim the remainder of the strip to 2" wide, cut one - 2" x 15-1/2" strip X.

- Three 1 1/2" x WOF strips.
 Sub cut one 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip T, one 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip O, one 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" strip R, and one 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" U.
- One 5-1/2" x WOF strip.
 Sub cut one 5-1/2" x 13-1/2" strip I. Trim the remainder of the strip to 5" wide, cut one 5" x 9-1/2" strip P.
- One 4-1/2" x WOF strip.
 Sub cut one 4-1/2" x 14" strip W. Trim the remainder of the strip to 4" wide, and cut one 4" x 8 1/2" strip F.

From Fabric C, cut:

• Two - 2" x WOF strips.

Sub cut two - 2" x 10" for A1 side borders and one - 2" x 15-1/2" for A1 bottom border, one- 2" x 1-1/2" and one - 2" x 2" for A2 pieced bottom border. one- 2" x 15-1/2" piece for A3 top border and one - 2" x 10" left side border.

- One 1-1/2" x WOF strip.
 Sub cut two 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" for B1 top and bottom borders, and one 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" for B1 left side border.
- One 1-3/4" x WOF strip.

Sub cut two - 1-3/4" x 7" for C1 top and bottom borders, one - 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" for C1 right side border, and one- 1-3/4" x 6" for C3 right side border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1-1/4" wide, and cut one - 1-1/4" x 8-1/2" for C1 left side border, and one - 1-1/4" x 2-1/4" for C3 pieced left side border.

From Fabric D, cut:

Two - 2" x WOF strips.

Sub cut one - 2" x 2" for A1 pieced top border, two - 2" x 10" for A2 side borders, one - 2" x 15-1/2" for A2 top border, one - 2" x 10" for A3 right side border and one - 1" x 2" for A3 pieced bottom border.

- One 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub cut two - 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" for B2 top and bottom borders and one - 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" for B2 right side border.
- One -1-3/4" x WOF strip.

Sub cut two - 1-3/4" x 7" for C2 top and bottom borders, one - 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" for C2 left side border, and one - 1-3/4" x 8-1/4" for C3 top border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1 1/4" wide, and cut one - 1-1/4" x 8-1/2" for C2 right side border and one - 1-1/4" x 2" for C3 pieced left side border.

From Fabric E, cut:

• One - 1" x WOF strip.

Sub cut two - 1" x 2" for A1 pieced top border and A2 pieced bottom border and one - 1" x 8-1/2" for C2 right side border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 3/4" wide, and cut one - 3/4" x 1-1/4" C3 pieced left side border.

From Fabric F, cut:

• One - 2" x WOF strip.

Sub cut one - 2" x 6-1/2" for A1 pieced top border, one - 2" x 6" for A2 pieced bottom border, and one - 2" x 2" for A3 pieced bottom border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1-3/4" wide, and cut one - 1 3/4" x 8-1/4" for C3 bottom border.

From Fabric G, cut:

• One - 1-1/2" x WOF strip.

Sub cut four - 1-1/2" x 2" for A1 pieced top border, A2 pieced bottom border and A3 pieced bottom border, and one - 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" for B2 left side border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1-1/4" wide, and cut one - 1-1/4" x 2" for C3 pieced left side border.

From Fabric H, cut:

• One - 2" x WOF strip.

Sub cut three - 2" x 1" for A1 pieced top border and A2 pieced bottom border and one - 2" x 6" strip for A3 pieced bottom border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1-1/2" wide, and cut one - 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip for B1 right side border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1" wide, and cut one - 1" x 8-1/2" for C3 left side border.

From Fabric I, cut:

• One - 1-1/4" x WOF strip.

Sub cut one - 1-1/4" x 2" strip for C3 pieced left side border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1" wide, and cut one - 1" x 10" for A1 left side border and three - 1" x 2" strips for A1 pieced top border, A2 pieced bottom border and A3 pieced bottom border.

From Fabric J, cut:

• One - 1-1/4" x WOF strip.

Sub cut one - 1-1/4" x 2" for C3 pieced left side border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1" wide, and cut two - 1" x 2" for A1 pieced top border and A3 pieced bottom

border. Cut one - 1" x 10" for A2 right side border and one - 1" x 8-1/2" for C1 left side border.

From Fabric K, cut:

• One - 1-1/2" x WOF strip.

Sub cut two - $1-1/2" \times 2"$ for A1 pieced top border and A3 pieced bottom border. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1" wide, and cut 1 - 1 x 2" for A2 pieced bottom border and one - 1" x 10" for A3 right side border.

From binding fabric, cut:

• Five - 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

1. Starting with A1 pieced border, sew it together, using the pieces referred to in the illustration. *Figure 1*. Press.

Note: The pieces can be arranged in any order you like, just make sure you use all eight pieces for the A1 pieced border.

Sew the pieced border to the top of one of the A - 8 1/2" x 12" blocks. Sew the side border pieces to each side of the block. Press.

Sew the bottom border piece to the block. Press.

Repeat for A2 and A3 blocks, starting with the pieced border pieces for each one, and continue sewing the block together as you did for A1.

2. Using the B blocks and referring to the illustration, first sew the right border on one block, then the left border on the other block. *Figure* 2. Press.




Referring to the Elephant Unit Assembly Diagrams, sew the top and bottom borders on each block. Press.



Sew the long side border to the remaining side of each of the blocks. Press.


3. Using the C blocks and starting with C1 and C2, sew the top and bottom borders on each of these. *Figure 3.* Press.

Referring to the Elephant Unit Assembly Diagrams, sew the right side piece on block C1 and the left side piece on block C2 side. Press.

Sew the C1 and C2 pieced border pieces together, and sew to the remaining side of each block. Press.







Starting with the C3 block, sew the right side border piece to the block. *Figure 4*. Press.

Sew the top and bottom borders to the block. Press.

Sew the C3 pieced border pieces together. Press. Sew the pieced border to the remaining (narrow) border strip.

Press and sew to the left side of the block. Press.

4. Lay out your pieces, referring to the illustration.

Starting with Section 1, sew F to B1.


Press and sew H to the left side of this unit. Figure 5. Press.

Sew M to the bottom of this unit. Press.

Sew C2 to P. Press and sew N to the right side of this unit. Sew this to *M*, press and sew G to the left side of the complete unit. Press and set aside.

5. Continue joining pieces to make units: Sew A1 to J, press and sew this unit to I. *Figure 6*.



Sew O to C1, press and sew L to the left side of this unit. Sew C3 to Q, press and sew to the bottom of the L-C1-O unit.



Sew K to B2 to S. Press and sew R to the left side of this unit.

Press and sew to the right hand side of the L-C1-O-C3 unit. *Figure 8.*







6. Sew the bottom section together, starting with sewing A2 to V. Press and sew U to A3 to X. Press and sew W to the left hand side of this.

Sew the A2-V unit to the left side of W. Press. Figure 10.



Sew this unit to the top unit. Figure 11. Press.



7. Sew D1 to the left side of the quilt top and D2 to the right side of the quilt top. Figure 12. Press.

Your quilt top is done. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
