

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From **Fabric A**, cut: two 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-7/8" squares

Twenty 2-770 squares

From **Fabric B**, cut: two 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 2-7/8" squares

From **Fabric C**, cut:

four 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-7/8" x 7-3/4" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

four 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 2-7/8" x 7-3/4" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

one 7-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: five 7-3/4" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

one 7-3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 7-3/4" squares

From **Fabric G**, cut:

five from Template A

Note: Cut on the inner circle line if you wish to use raw edge appliqué. Cut on the outer circle line if you wish to use a turned edge method.

From **Fabric H**, cut:

four from Template A


Note: Cut on the inner circle line if you wish to use raw edge appliqué. Cut on the outer circle line if you wish to use a turned edge method.

From **binding fabric**, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Appliqué the Circles

Fold and lightly press the Fabric E and F squares lengthwise and widthwise into quarters. Repeat for all circle template pieces. This process helps to center the circles in the squares.



Center Fabric G circle on a Fabric E square. Pin and appliqué the circle to the square by either using a small zigzag stitch (raw edge applique) or turning the raw edge under by 1/4" and hand stitching around the circle with a blind stitch.

Repeat for all E/G blocks and F/H blocks.


Assemble the Blocks



Gather all Fabric E/G blocks, Fabric A and Fabric C pieces. Sew the block into three rows of three units each. Press unit seams to the left in the first and third rows and to the right in the second row. Press row seams open. Make five blocks.

Repeat the process using the Fabric F/H blocks, Fabric B and Fabric D pieces. Make four blocks.

Assemble the Quilt



Arrange the blocks, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, into three rows of three. Press block seams to the left in the first and third rows and to the right in the second row. Press row seams open.

Your quilt top is now complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
