

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.



Notes:

- Backing and binding is not included in the supply list above. These material requirements will be given in Month 13 of the Block of the Month.
- The specific fabric colors used in the block shown on the cover can be found on page 6.
- Save all leftover fabric for Month 13.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and G, cut:

one 4-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 4-7/8" squares of each fabric, then subcut each square once on the diagonal.

From each of Fabrics B-D, cut:

one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 2-7/8" squares, then subcut each square once on the diagonal.

From Fabric E, cut:

one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 2-7/8" squares of each fabric, then subcut each square once on the diagonal.

From Fabric F, cut:

one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 2-7/8" squares, then subcut each square once on the diagonal.

From Fabric H, cut:

two 4-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 4-7/8" squares of each fabric, then subcut each square once on the diagonal.

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Gather the Fabric A and Fabric H triangles. Place one triangle of each fabric RST and sew along the long edge. Press towards the darker fabric. Repeat to make four large HSTs. Trim each large HST to 4-1/2" if needed.

Step 2: Gather eight Fabric C triangles, four Fabric D triangles, eight Fabric E triangles, and four Fabric F triangles. Place a Fabric C triangle RST with a Fabric E triangle and sew along the long edge. Press towards the darker fabric. Repeat with the remaining triangles to make twelve small HSTs in the fabric combinations and quantities shown below. Trim each small HST to 2-1/2" if needed.







Assemble the Triangle Units

Step 3: Gather four Fabric B triangles, four Fabric C triangles, four Fabric H triangles, and the small D/E HSTs. Sew a Fabric B triangle to the top of a HST, then press towards the triangle. Sew a Fabric C triangle to the right edge of the HST, then press towards the triangle. Sew a Fabric H triangle to the long edge of the unit, then press. Repeat with the remaining triangles and HSTs to make four identical triangle units.



Step 4: Gather four Fabric B triangles, four Fabric D triangles, four Fabric H triangles, and the small C/E HSTs. Sew a Fabric D triangle to the bottom of a HST, then press towards the triangle. Sew a Fabric B triangle to the left edge of the HST, then press towards the triangle. Sew a Fabric H triangle to the long edge of the unit, then press. Repeat with the remaining triangles and HSTs to make four identical triangle units.




Step 5: Gather four Fabric B triangles, four Fabric D triangles, four Fabric G triangles, and the small C/F HSTs. Sew a Fabric B triangle to the bottom of a HST, then press towards the triangle. Sew a Fabric D triangle to the left edge of the HST, then press towards the triangle. Sew a Fabric G triangle to the long edge of the unit, then press. Repeat with the remaining triangles and HSTs to make four identical triangle units.



Assemble the Quadrants

Step 6: Gather one large HST, one Step 3 Unit, one Step 4 Unit, and one Step 5 Unit. Arrange the units in two rows of two as shown. Sew the units together to form rows, then press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Repeat to make four identical quadrants.






Step 8: Arrange the quadrants you have created in two rows of two as shown. Pay close attention to the orientation of the quadrants.


Step 9: Sew the quadrants together to form rows and press the seams in opposite directions.

Step 10: Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press to complete the block.

Safely store this block until Month 13 of the Block of the Month to finish your quilt.
