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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

eleven 7" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-three 7" squares for the HSTs
seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 3-1/2" $\times 72-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
two 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
From each of Fabrics B-H, cut:
two 7" x WOF strips. Subcut:
nine 7" squares for the HSTs

## From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 7" Fabric A square with a 7" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 6-1/2" square. Repeat to make eighteen A/B HSTs.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

eighteen A/C HSTs

eighteen A/D HSTs

eighteen A/E HSTs

eighteen A/F HSTs

eighteen A/G HSTs

eighteen A/H HSTs

Note: Not all HSTs will be used.


Step 3: Arrange the blocks into twelve rows of ten blocks. Note the block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Arrange the HSTs in a fabric placement of your choosing.

Step 4: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 5: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Step 6: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
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
