- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one $23^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center panel

## From Fabric $B$, cut:

four 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/4" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 1 strips
two 1-1/4" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 1 strips

## From Fabric C, cut:

five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 4-1/2" $\times 22^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for the side Border 2 units
two 4-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for the top/bottom Border 2 units twenty 4-1/2" squares for Border 2
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2-1/2" $\times 52^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 4 strips two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 strips

## From Fabric D-H and J-M, cut:

two 3" circles using Template 1 or your preferred circle cutting method.
Note: These sizes reflect raw edge appliqué. If you choose to use needle turn, use Template 2
or cut a 3-1/2" circle.

## From Fabric I, cut:

six $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 5-1/2" $\times 56^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 5 strips
two 5-1/2" $\times 48$-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 strips
two 3 " circles using Template 1 or your preferred circle cutting method.

## From Fabric N , cut:

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 3 strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 34-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 3 strips
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Fold and press each Fabric D-M circle in half along the length and width to press creases along the quarter.


Step 2: Repeat with all 4-1/2" Fabric C squares.
Step 3: Place one Fabric D circle right side up on a Fabric C square, aligning the creases in the circle with the seams in the square. Appliqué the circle to the square using your preferred raw edge appliqué method, such as a small zig zag stitch or blanket stitch.

Note: Alternately, if using Template 2, use needle turn appliqué to stitch the circle to the unit, hiding the raw edges.


Repeat Step 3 for all Fabric D-M circles to create twenty Circle Units.



Step 4: Sew together Circle Units, in this order: Fabric I + Fabric J + Fabric K + Fabric L + Fabric M. Press. Sew the $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle to the strip at the Fabric M end. Repeat to make a second unit like this. These are the side Border 2 units.

Step 5: Sew together Circle Units, in this order: Fabric D + Fabric E + Fabric F + Fabric G + Fabric H. Press. Sew the $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle to the strip at the Fabric H end. Repeat to make a second unit like this. These are the top/bottom Border 2 units.

Step 6: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border
 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the side Border 5 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 5 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
