Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

two 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Set the strips aside for strip-piecing.
four 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Set the strips aside for strip-piecing.
five 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty 4-1/4" squares.

six 2" x WOF strips. Set the strips aside for strip-piecing.
thirteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips.

Set twelve two strips aside for strip-piecing.

From the eleven remaining strips, subcut:

forty 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles.

six 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.

From Fabric B, cut:

twenty-two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" squares.

Set all of the full and partial strips aside for strip-piecing.

From Fabric C, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips.

Set one strip aside for strip-piecing.

Sew the remaining six strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 61-1/2" middle side borders.

two 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" middle top/bottom borders.

From Fabric D, cut:

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 63-1/2" outer side borders.

two 3-1/2" x 57-1/2" outer top/bottom borders.

two 2-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 2-3/8" squares.

From each of Fabrics E-K, cut:

two 2-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

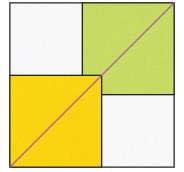
twenty 2-3/8" squares.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

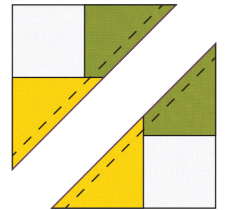
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Flying Geese

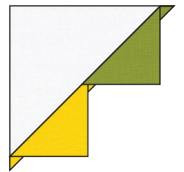
Step 1: Pin two 2-3/8" squares cut from Fabrics D-K in opposing corners of a 4-1/4" Fabric A square, RST. The squares will overlap slightly in the center of the large square. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the squares.



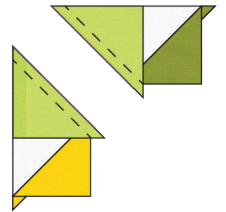
Step 2: Sew scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set the seam by pressing it flat. Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.



Step 3: Press the fabric toward smaller triangles. Repeat with the second unit.



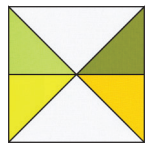
Step 4: Place one 2-3/8" square cut from Fabric D-K at the corner of a sewn block unit. Draw a diagonal line in pencil. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set seam (press). Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.



Step 5: Press the seam toward the smaller triangle. Trim off small dog ears left by the seam allowance. Trim to 2" x 3-1/2" if necessary. Repeat to make one-hundred and sixty flying geese units.

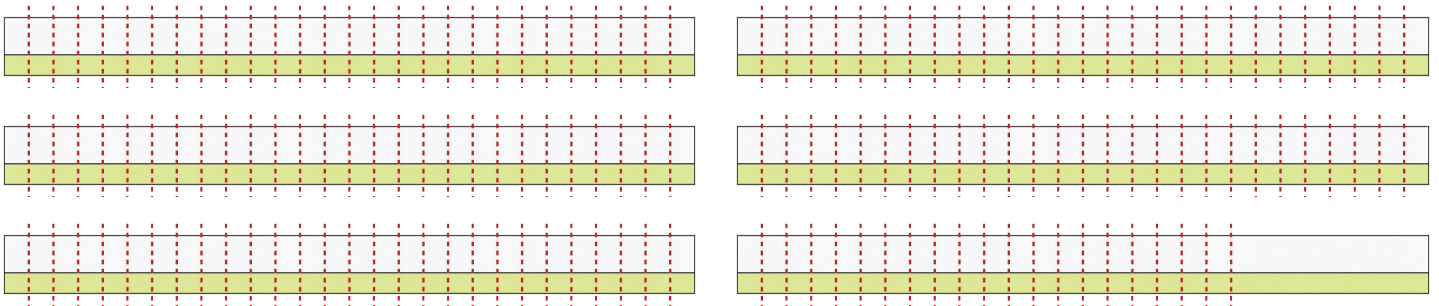


Step 6: Sew two flying geese together as shown. Repeat to make eighty middle units.

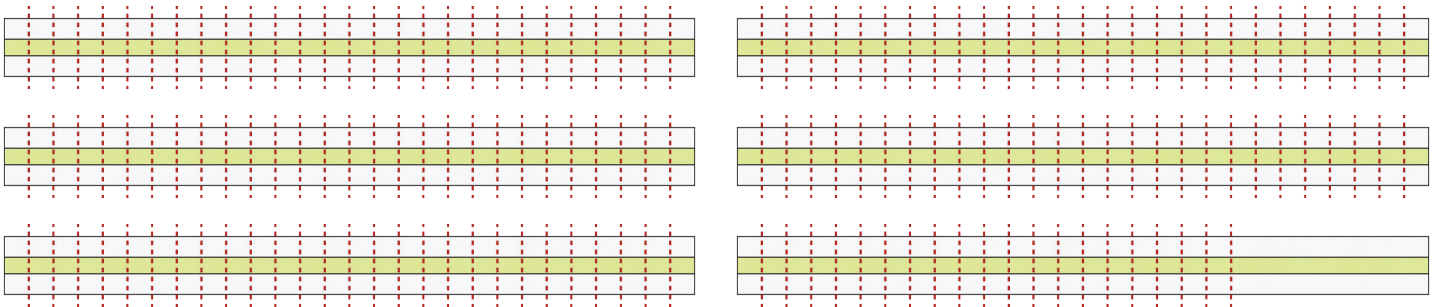


Assemble the Strip-Pieced Units

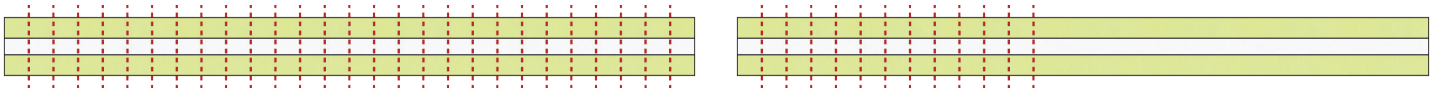
Step 5: Sew one 2-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip to one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip. Press the seam toward the Fabric B strip. Repeat to make six strip sets. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seams from the strip sets. Cut one-hundred and sixty 3-1/2" A/B segments.



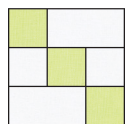
Step 6: Sew one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip between two 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strips. Press the seams toward the Fabric B strip. Repeat to make six strip sets. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seams from the strip sets. Cut one-hundred and sixty 3-1/2" A/B/A segments.



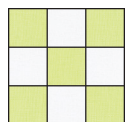
Step 7: Sew one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip between two 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips. Press the seams toward the Fabric B strip. Repeat to make two strip sets. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seams from the strip sets. Cut forty 3-1/2" B/A/B segments.



Step 8: Sew one 3-1/2" A/B/A segment between two 3-1/2" A/B segments as shown. Repeat to make eighty corner units.



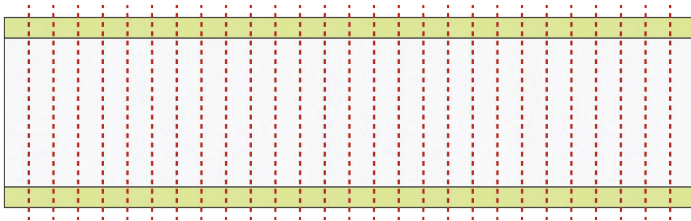
Step 9: Sew one 3-1/2" A/B/A segment between two 3-1/2" B/A/B segments as shown. Repeat to make twenty center units.



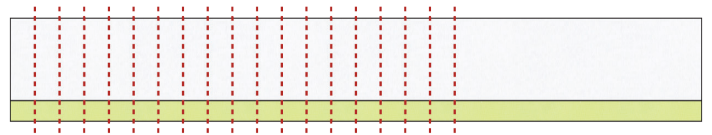
Step 10: Sew the partial length 1-1/2" Fabric B strip between 5-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strips. Press the seams toward the Fabric C strip. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seams of the strip set. Cut fifteen vertical sashing strips.



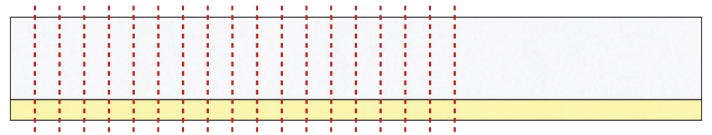
Step 11: Sew one 9-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip between two 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips. Press the seams toward the Fabric B strips. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seams of the strip set. Cut forty 11-1/2" B/A/B segments.



Step 12: Sew one 5-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip to one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip. Press the seam toward the Fabric B strip. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seam of the strip set. Cut eighteen 6-1/2" A/B segments.



Step 13: Sew one 5-1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip to one 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric C strip. Press the seam toward the Fabric C strip. Cut 1-1/2" wide segments perpendicular to the seam of the strip set. Cut eighteen 6-1/2" A/C segments.



Step 14: Sew three 6-1/2" A/B segments, four 6-1/2" A/C segments, and one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A rectangle together in a row, alternating between A/C and A/B segments and placing the rectangle at the end. Press the seams toward the B and C squares. Repeat to make a six horizontal sashing strips.

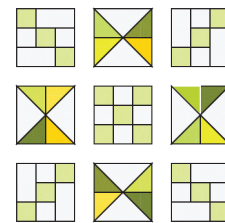


Step 16: Sew five 6-1/2" A/B segments, five 6-1/2" A/C segments, and one 1-1/2" Fabric B square together in a row, alternating between A/B and A/C segments and placing the square at the end. Press the seam toward the B and K squares. Repeat to make a second side pieced border.

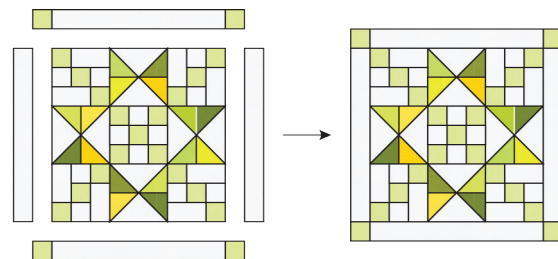


Assemble the Blocks

Step 17: Gather four middle units, four corner units, and one center unit. Arrange and sew the units in three rows of three as shown. Make twenty star units.



Step 18: Gather one star unit, two 1-1/2" B/A/B segments, and two 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric A rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to the sides of the star unit, then press. Sew the B/A/B segments to the top and bottom of the unit and press. Make twenty blocks.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 19: Arrange the blocks into five rows of four blocks. Separate the blocks in each row with a vertical sashing strip.

Step 20: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press.

Step 21: Separate the rows with a horizontal sashing strip. Place a horizontal sashing strip at the top and bottom of the arrangement as well.

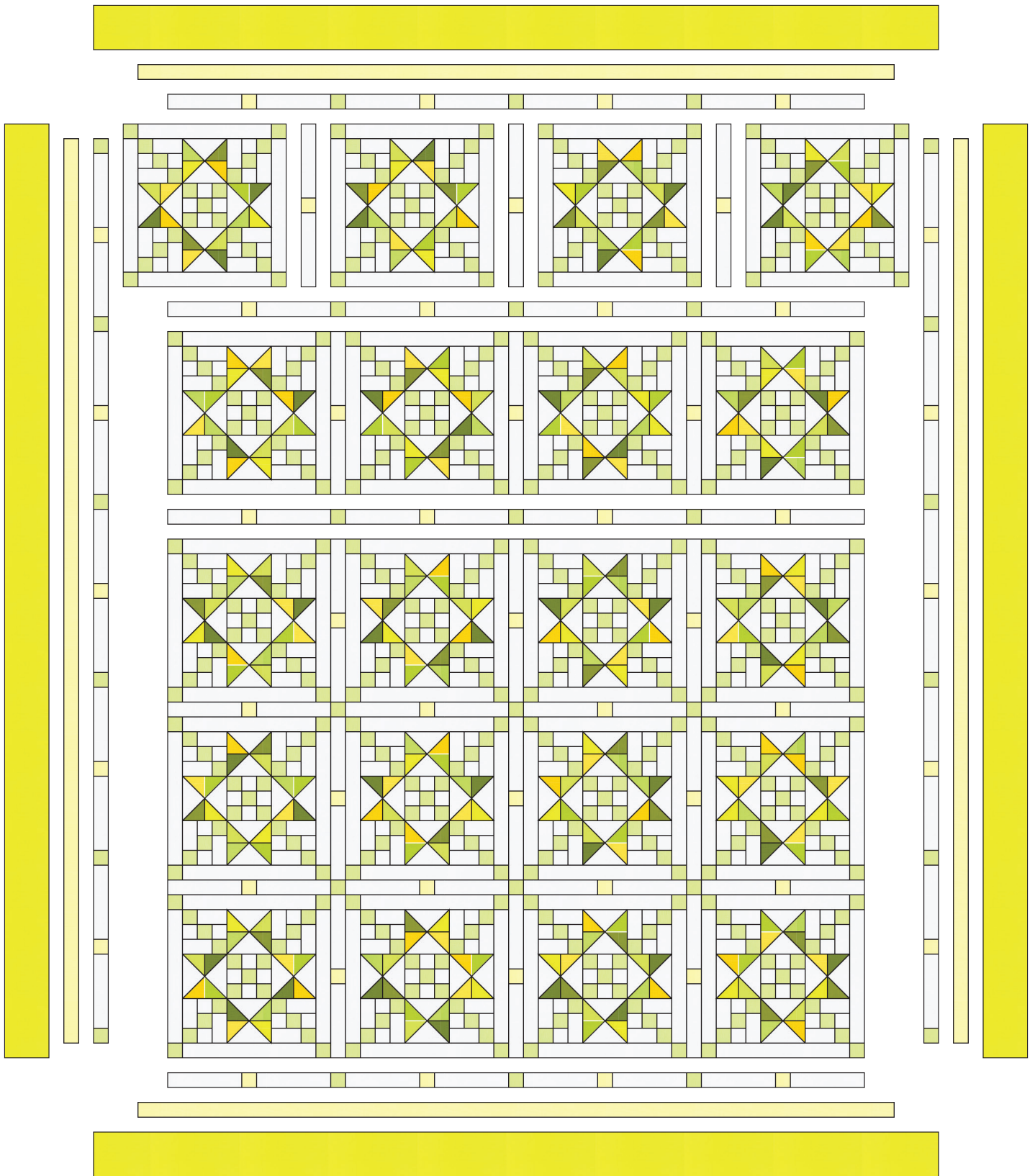
Step 22: Sew the rows and horizontal sashing strips together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 23: Sew the side pieced borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 24: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 25: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
