



## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, cut:

- six 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - eighty-four 3" squares
- nineteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - twenty-four 2-1/2" x 16" rectangles
  - twenty-four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
  - twenty-four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
  - forty-eight 2-1/2" squares
- twelve 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - twenty-four 2-1/4" x 19-1/2" rectangles

### From each of Fabrics B and I, cut:

- two 3" x WOF strips of each fabric. Subcut:
  - twenty-eight 3" squares of each fabric
- three 2-1/2" x WOF strips of each fabric. Subcut:
  - forty 2-1/2" squares of each fabric

**From each of Fabrics C and P, cut:**

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips of each fabric. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

**From each of Fabrics D, E, F, K, L, M, Q, R, and S, cut:**

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips of each fabric. Subcut:  
four 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

**From each of Fabrics G, N, and T, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip of each fabric. Subcut:  
four 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

**From Fabric H, O, and U, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip of each fabric. Subcut:  
four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

**From Fabric J, cut:**

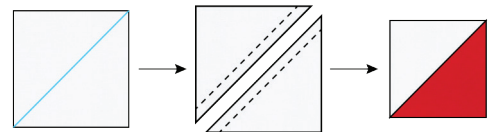
two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty-eight 3" squares  
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle  
forty 2-1/2" squares

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs).

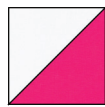


Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make fifty-six A/B HSTs.

**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



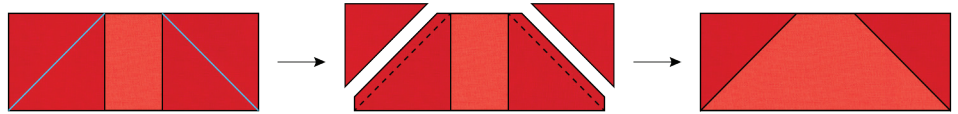
fifty-six A/I HSTs



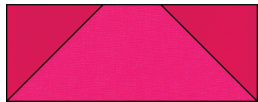
fifty-six A/J HSTs

## Assemble the Stitch-and-Flip (SNF) Units

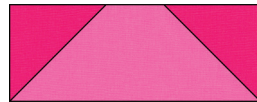
**Step 3:** Gather two 2-1/2" Fabric B squares and one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the reverse side of each square, then place it on top of the rectangle, RST. Sew on the marked line, then trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press towards the darker fabric. Make eight B/C SNF Units.



**Step 4:** Repeat Step 3 to make:



eight I/J SNF Units



eight J/P SNF Units

**Step 5:** Repeat Step 3 using 2-1/2" squares and 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to make:



four B/F SNF Units



four I/M SNF Units



four J/S SNF Units

**Step 6:** Repeat Step 3 using 2-1/2" squares and 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to make:



four B/G SNF Units

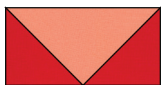

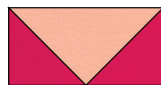

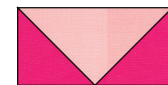
**Step 7:** Repeat Step 3 using 2-1/2" square and 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to make:



four B/H SNF Units



four I/O SNF Units

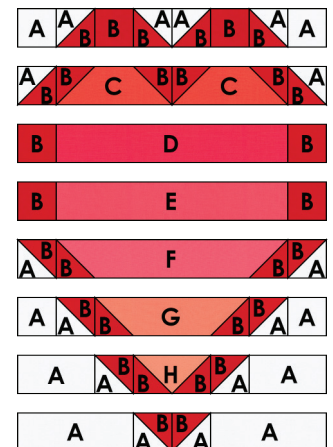


four J/U SNF Units

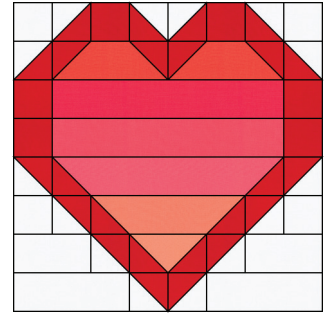
## Assemble the Blocks

**Step 8:** Arrange four 2-1/2" Fabric A squares, two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangles, two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangles, six 2-1/2" Fabric B squares, one 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric D rectangle, one 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric E rectangle, fourteen A/B HSTs, two B/C SNF Units, one B/F SNF Unit, one B/G SNF Unit, one B/H SNF Unit into eight rows. Note the fabric placement and unit orientation in the diagram.

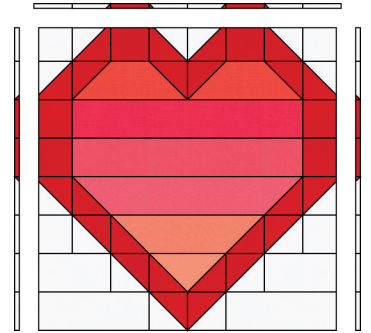
**Step 9:** Sew the pieces in each row together. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.



**Step 10:** Sew the rows together to form the heart unit. Press the rows open.



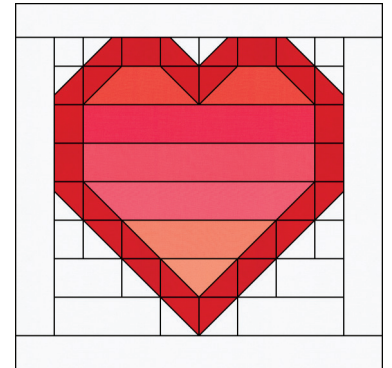
**Step 11:** Measure 16" from the bottom edge of the heart unit and trim the top edge. Measure 7-3/4" from the vertical center of the heart unit and trim both sides. The heart unit should now measure 15-1/2" x 16".



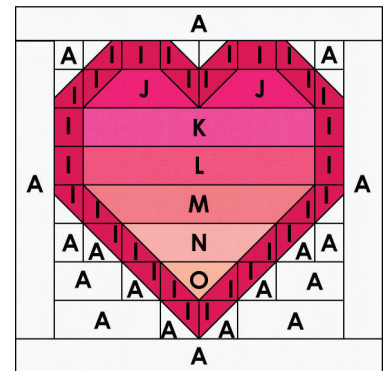
**Step 12:** Sew a 2-1/2" x 16" Fabric A rectangle to the left and right edges of the heart unit. Press toward the rectangles.

**Step 13:** Sew a 2-1/4" x 19-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the heart unit. Press toward the rectangles to complete the block.

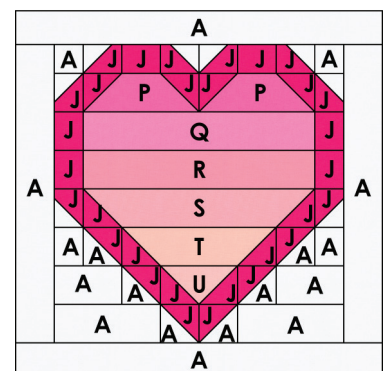
**Step 14:** Repeat Steps 8-13 to make four blocks.



**Step 15:** Repeat Steps 8-14 to make four blocks as shown in the diagram.



**Step 16:** Repeat Steps 8-14 to make four blocks as shown in the diagram.



## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 17:** Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the block placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 18:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

**Step 19:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy
