

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 22-1/2" x 38-1/2" center panel

From Fabric B, cut:

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" side Border 3 strips

two 3-1/2" x 40-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" side Border 1 strips

two 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

From Fabric C, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 5" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric D. cut:

three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighteen 5" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric E, cut:

two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut: ten 5" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric F, cut:

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" side Border 2 strips

two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)




Step 1: Pair a 5" Fabric D square with a 5" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty D/E HSTs.

Step 2: Place a Fabric C square on the work surface, with the fabric face up and the print oriented in the correct way (trees pointing up). Place a Fabric D square on top of the Fabric C square, right sides together. Mark a diagonal like from lower left to upper right. Repeat the process in Step 1 to make eight C/D HSTs in this orientation.



Step 3: Repeat the process in Step 2, but mark the line from upper left to lower right to make eight C/D HSTs in this orientation.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 4: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 5: Gather two C/D HSTs (one of each orientation) and four D/E HSTs. Arrange as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram to form the top pieced border. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center.




Step 6: Gather two C/D HSTs (one of each orientation) and four D/E HSTs. Arrange as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram to form the bottom pieced border. Sew to the bottom edge of the quilt center.



Step 7: Gather six C/D HSTs (three of each orientation) and six D/E HSTs. Arrange as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram to form the left pieced border. Sew to the left edge of the quilt center.

Step 8: Gather six C/D HSTs (three of each orientation) and six D/E HSTs. Arrange as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram to form the right pieced border. Sew to the right edge of the quilt center.



Step 9: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
