## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From the Roll Up:

- Sort the strips into four pairs of fabrics for lanterns, using the quilt image as a guide.
- Again using the quilt image as a guide, cut the lantern fabrics into four 10" strips for each of the tall/narrow lanterns or three 13-1/2" length strips for each of the the wide lanterns.
- Gather the strips used for the lantern tops and subcut into six pieces $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ and six pieces $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Gather the print strips used for the pieced accent border. Cut a total of twenty-six strips $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Gather the strips that match the background fabric. Sew together, end-to-end, and trim to make two 2-1/2" x 50" for the sashing between rows.


## From Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ (the background fabric), cut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one hundred eighty-four 2-1/2" squares
twelve $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles
twelve 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles
Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, and trim to yield:
two 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" for top/bottom outer borders
two 2-1/2" x 67-1/2" for the side outer borders
five 2 " x WOF strips. Subcut
nine 2 " $\times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips
three 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, and trim to yield:
two 2-3/4" x 58-1/2" side inner borders
three 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, and trim to yield:
two $3^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders
From the binding fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Set aside twelve 2-1/2" Fabric A squares for Step 2. Mark a diagonal line on the back of each remaining 2-1/2" Fabric A square. Place a square at the end of each 10 " or 13-1/2" lantern fabric, noting the orientation of the diagonal line in the illustration here. Sew along the diagonal line and cut away the excess fabric, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press the seam toward the triangle.


Step 2: Sew each of the twelve Fabric A squares set aside in Step 1 to opposite ends of each $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " lantern top. Press toward the lantern top fabric. Repeat to make a total of six for the narrow lanterns.


Step 3: Sew each of the twelve 2-1/2" $\times 4$ " Fabric A rectangles to opposite ends of each 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" lantern top. Press toward the lantern top fabric. Repeat to make a total of six for the wide lanterns.


Step 4: Gather and arrange the eight lantern strips and one lantern top for the first narrow lantern block. Note the fabric placement and strip orientation. Sew the strips together to form the block. Press the seams open or to one side. Repeat to make six narrow lantern blocks, each measuring 10 " x 18-1/2".


Step 5: Gather and arrange the six lantern strips, two 13-1/2" Fabric A strips and one lantern top for the first wide lantern block. Note the fabric placement and strip orientation. Sew the strips together to form the block. Press the seams open or to one side. Repeat to make six wide lantern blocks, each measuring $13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


Assemble the Quilt Center


Step 6: Arrange the narrow and wide lantern blocks to form three rows of four blocks each, as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

Step 7: Sew the block rows together, placing a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50$ " Fabric A sashing strip between each row. Press seams open or to the sashing.


Step 8: Sew the $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 3 " $\times 54-1 / 2 "$ top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew six of the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border strips together. Press the seams to one side. Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric A square to each each of the strip to complete the bottom middle border. Repeat to create the top middle border.


Step 10: Sew seven of the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border strips together. Press the seams to one side to complete the side middle border. Repeat to create a second side middle border.


Step 11: Sew the side middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
