## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

fifty-five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. From seventeen of the strips, cut:
one hundred thirty-two 1-1/2" $\times 5$ " block sashing strips
Sew the remaining strips together and cut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips
two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" strips
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31$ " strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 41-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 52$ " strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 73^{\prime \prime}$ strips
two 1-1/2" x 85" strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 95-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
two 1-1/2" x 106" strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 117^{\prime \prime}$ strips
one 1-1/2" x 122" strip
Note: Sew WOF strips together, end-to-end, as needed in order to make these lengths.

## From seventy-eight of the Ten Square pieces:

cut each square in half to form two 5 " $\times 10$ " rectangles, for a total of one hundred fifty-six
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Prepare the Blocks

Step 1: Press each 5" x 10" rectangle in half, as shown, bringing the 5" ends together. Unfold. These creases will aid in the final assembly. These rectangles will now be referred to as Blocks.


## Assemble the Rows

Step 2: Sew two Blocks together, placing a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric A sashing strip between the two Blocks. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a second row like this.

Step 3: Sew a 20-1/2" Fabric A strip to one edge of each row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 4: Sew three Blocks together, placing a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a second row like this.

Step 5: Sew a 31" Fabric A strip to one edge of each row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 6: Sew four Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" x 5" Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a second row like this.

Step 7: Sew a 41-1/2" Fabric A strip to one edge of each row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 8: Sew five Blocks together, placing a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a second row like this.

Step 9: Sew a 52" Fabric A strip to one edge of each row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 10: Sew six Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" x 5" Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a second row like this.

Step 11: Sew a 62-1/2" Fabric A strip to one edge of each row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 12: Sew seven Blocks together, placing a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a second row like this.

Step 13: Sew a 73" Fabric A strip to one edge of each row, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 14: Sew eight Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" x 5" Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a total of two rows like this.

Step 15: Sew an 85" Fabric A strip to one edge of two of the rows, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 16: Sew nine Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" $\times 5$ " Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a total of two rows like this.

Step 17: Sew an 95-1/2" Fabric A strip to one edge of two of the rows, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 18: Sew ten Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" x 5" Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a total of two rows like this.

Step 19: Sew an 106" Fabric A strip to one edge of two of the rows, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 20: Sew eleven Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a total of two rows like this.

Step 21: Sew an 117" Fabric A strip to one edge of two of the rows, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing.


Step 22: Sew twelve Blocks together, placing a 1-1/2" $\times 5$ " Fabric A sashing strip between each Block. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make a total of two rows like this.

Step 23: Sew a $122^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to one edge of one of the rows, centering along the length. Press toward the sashing. Note that one of the rows will not have the sashing sewn to it at this point.


There will be two Blocks remaining, which will be used on the final rows/corners of the quilt in Step 20.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 24: Center and sew one row from Step 3 to one row from Step 5, as shown. Using the creases from Step 1, center the creases to align as closely as you can to the center of the block sashing strips. Press. Repeat to make a second unit like this.


Step 25: Center and sew one row from Step 7 to one unit from Step 24, as shown. Using the creases from Step 1, center the creases to align as closely as you can to the center of the block sashing strips. Press. Repeat to make a second unit like this.


Step 26: Continue to add rows from Steps $9,11,13,15,17,19$ and 21 to each section of the quilt, as you did in Steps 24 and 25. You will have two large triangle portions of the quilt at this point.

Step 27: Carefully place the remaining row of blocks (left over from Step 23) between the two halves of the quilt. Notice how they are offset to form the final quilt top. Sew this row of blocks to each half. Press.

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Step 28: Sew a 10" Fabric A strip to one long edge of two remaining blocks. Press. Center and sew these units to the remaining unfinished corners of the quilt. Press.

Step 29: Trim the quilt top to approximately $84^{\prime \prime} \times 93^{\prime \prime}$, cutting off the ends of each row to square up the quilt. Because the outer edges of the quilt are now bias edges, you may wish to sew a line of stay-stitching around the outermost edge of the quilt, $1 / 8$ " from the edge. This will prevent the quilt top from stretching during quilting.


Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
