








Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 43" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 9-3/4" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

eleven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 1-1/2" x 9-3/4" strips

eighteen 1-1/2" x 11-3/4" strips

From Fabric C, cut:

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 46" top/bottom outer borders

two 3-1/2" x 64-1/4" side outer borders

four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

two 3-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 3-3/8" x 11-3/4" strips

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fifty-two 2-1/2" squares

six 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 2" x 43" strips

forty-eight 2" squares

two 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 1-3/4" x 11-3/4" strips

From Fabric D, cut:

one 1-1/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 1-1/8" x 9-3/4" strips

two 1-1/8" x 8-1/2" strips

From each of Fabrics E-G, cut:

one 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

three 3" squares

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric H, cut:

one 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

three 3" squares

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" squares

five 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2" x 43" top/bottom inner borders

two 2" x 58-1/4" side inner borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles

Step 1: Pair a 2-1/2" Fabric C square with a 2-1/2" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2" square. Repeat to make twenty-four C/E HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:



twenty-four C/F HSTs



twenty-four C/G HSTs



twenty-four C/H HSTs



twelve E/G HSTs



twelve E/F HSTs



twelve F/H HSTs



twelve H/G HSTs

Step 3: Pair a 3" Fabric C square with a 3" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make:



Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make:



two C/F HSTs



two C/G HSTs



two C/H HSTs



one E/G HST
(the extra will not be
used)



one E/F HST
(the extra will not be
used)



one F/H HST
(the extra will not be
used)



one H/G HST
(the extra will not be
used)

Assemble the Star Blocks

Step 5: Gather 2" units of the following:

two C/E HSTs
two C/F HSTs
two C/G HSTs
two C/H HSTs
one E/G HST
one E/F HST
one F/H HST
one H/G HST
four Fabric C squares



Arrange in four rows of four, following the fabric placement and block orientation shown in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew the squares together to form rows, pressing the row seams in opposite directions. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side. The resulting block should measure 6-1/2" square.

Repeat to make twelve blocks.



Step 6: Repeat Step 5 with 2-1/2" square units to make the center Star Block. Sew a 1-1/8" x 8-1/2" Fabric D strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press. Sew a 1-1/8" x 9-3/4" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press. Sew a 1-1/2" x 9-3/4" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press. Sew a 1-1/2" x 11-3/4" Fabric B strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press.

The block will measure 11-3/4" square.

Assemble the Statue Blocks

Step 7: Sew a 1-1/2" x 9-3/4" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom edges of a Fabric A square. Press. Sew a 1-1/2" x 11-3/4" Fabric B strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press. The block will measure 11-3/4" square. Repeat to make eight Statue Blocks.



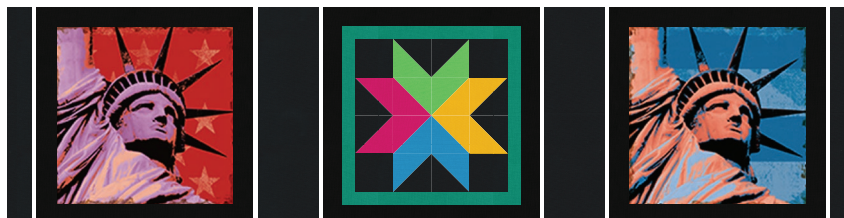
Assemble the Rows

Step 8: Gather:
two 1-3/4" x 11-3/4" Fabric C strips
three Statue Blocks
two 3-3/8" x 11-3/4" Fabric C strips

Sew together to form Row 1. Press toward the Fabric C strips. Repeat to make Row 5.

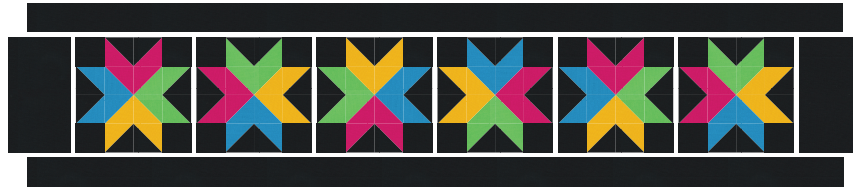


Step 9: Repeat Step 8 to make Row 3, placing the Step 6 Star Block in the middle of the row.



Step 10: Gather:
two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C rectangles
six Star Blocks

Sew together to form Row 2, noting the block orientation in the diagram. Press the seams open or to one side. Sew a 2" x 43" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom edges of the row. Press.



Repeat to make Row 4, noting the differences in the block orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 11: Sew Rows 1-5 together. Press. Sew a 2" x 43" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom edges of the quilt.

Step 12: Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
