

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

one 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: three 6-1/2" squares for the Block Centers

From Fabric B, fussy cut:

twelve 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the Block Sashing, centering the print to be the same for each rectangle

From Fabric C, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

one 14-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: one 14-1/2" square. Cut along both diagonals, creating four setting triangles.

From Fabric E, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 3-1/2" x 33" border strips two 3-1/2" x 17" border strips two 3-1/2" x 20" border strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Sew a Fabric C square to opposite ends of a Fabric B rectangle. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make six units like this.



Step 2: Sew a Fabric B sashing strip to opposite ends of a Fabric A square. Press toward the sashing. Repeat to make three units like this.



Step 3: Sew the units from Step 1 and Step 2 together, as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side. Repeat to make three blocks, each measuring 10-1/2" square.




Assemble the Table Runner

Step 4: Sew the side setting triangles to each block as shown. Press. The triangles are slightly oversized.




Step 5: Sew row to row, nesting the seams and pressing to one side. Trim the excess from Fabric D, being sure to leave 1/4" of fabric beyond the outer points of the Fabric C squares.



Step 6: Sew the longest border strips to the long sides of the table runner. Press. Trim the excess, as shown.




Step 7: Sew the shortest border strips to the left and right sides of the table runner. Press. Trim the excess, as shown.



Step 8: Sew the remaining border strips to the top and bottom sides of the table runner. Press. Trim the excess, as shown.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
