



Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, cut:

- two 17-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 17-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangles
- one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 8-1/2" squares
- five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles thirty-four 4-1/2" squares
- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangles two 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" short borders Sew the three remaining strips together end-to-end, then subcut: two 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" long borders
- four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty-eight 2" squares
- three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics B and E, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: seven 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics D, F and G, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

one Fabric C left unit

four Fabric F left units

Step 1: Place two 2" Fabric A squares on the top corners of a 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle. Place a 4-1/2" Fabric A square on the bottom edge of the rectangle. Mark diagonal lines across each of the squares as shown. Sew on the marked lines, then trim away the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press to complete a left unit.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make a total of:



six Fabric B left units



two Fabric E left units

Step 3: Place two 2" Fabric A squares on the top corners of a 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric C rectangle. Place a 4-1/2" Fabric A square on the bottom edge of the rectangle. Mark diagonal lines across each of the squares as shown. Sew on the marked lines, then trim away the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press to complete a right unit.

Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make a total of:



six Fabric C right units



one Fabric F right unit



one Fabric D right unit




four Fabric G right units



four Fabric D left units



one Fabric G left unit





four Fabric E right units

Step 5: Sew a Fabric B left unit and Fabric C right unit together to form a heart as shown. Press. Make six B/C hearts.

Step 6: Repeat Step 5 to make a total of:



one E/D heart






one G/F heart

Note: Save the remaining Fabric C and Fabric E left units for the table runner.

Assemble the Table Runner

Refer to the Table Runner Assembly Diagram for fabric placement.




Step 7: Arrange six heart blocks, six 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangles, and one right unit in a row. Sew the row together and press. Make two rows.

Step 8: Rotate one row, then sew the rows together lengthwise. Press.

Step 9: Sew the end borders to the short sides of the project center. Press toward the borders. Sew the long borders to the long sides of project center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

Assemble the Placemats



Step 10: Sew a 8-1/2" Fabric A square to the top edge of a remaining heart block. Press.

Step 11: Sew a 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the bottom edge of the unit.

Step 12: Sew a 17-1/2" x 20-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the right edge of the unit. Press.

Step 13: Sew a 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left edge of the unit. Press.

Step 14: Repeat Steps 10-13 to make four placemat tops. Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
