Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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You will also need:
5 yards for backing

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabrics B - O, cut:

six or seven 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles, for a total of ninety-six rectangles

From Fabric A, cut:

eleven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
ninety-six 4-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Units

Step 1: Sew a Fabric A square to the end of each print rectangle. Press toward the rectangle. Repeat to make ninety-six units like this, each measuring 4-1/2" x 13-1/2".



Assemble the Quilt



Step 2: Arrange the blocks into six rows of sixteen units. Note the block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Arrange the fabrics as shown in the Diagram, or in a random placement of your choosing.

Step 3: Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 4: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
