#### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42-1/2" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

# **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: one 5-1/4" square for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 4-1/2". Subcut: four 4-1/2" squares for Corner Units. Trim the remainder of the strip to 3-1/4". Subcut: three 3-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 3". Subcut: two 3" squares for HSTs. one 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Corner Units. one 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirteen 3-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: fourteen 3" squares for HSTs. ten 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: one-hundred and twenty-four 2-7/8" squares for Flying Geese. five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for Side Units. eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Corner Units. twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Side Units. eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Corner Units. eight 2-1/2" squares for Side Units.

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for Corner Units. fifty-two 1-1/2" squares for Corner Units.

#### From Fabric B, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 4-1/2". Subcut: one 4-1/2" square for Center Unit. one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 3" squares for HSTs.

Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-7/8". Subcut: four 2-7/8" squares for Flying Geese.

#### From Fabric C, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese.

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for HSTs.

one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 2-7/8" squares for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2". Subcut: four 2-1/2" squares for Center Unit.

#### From Fabric D, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:

three 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese.

Trim the remainder of the strip to 3". Subcut:

eight 3" squares for HSTs.

one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 2-7/8" squares for Flying Geese.

Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2". Subcut:

eight 2-1/2" squares—four for the Corner Units and four for the Center Unit.

one 1-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

sixteen 1-7/8" squares for Flying Geese.

#### From Fabric E, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-six 3" squares for HSTs. one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 2-7/8" squares for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2". Subcut: four 2-1/2" squares for Corner Units.

#### From Fabric F, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 3". Subcut: four 3" squares for HSTs. Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2". Subcut: four 2-1/2" squares for Corner Units. one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

fourteen 3" squares for HSTs.

one 1-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: sixteen 1-7/8" squares for Flying Geese.

#### From Fabric G, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 3". Subcut: two 3" squares for HSTs. one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: fourteen 3" squares for HSTs.

#### From Fabric H, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: one 5-1/4" square for Flying Geese. Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-7/8". Subcut: four 2-7/8" squares for Flying Geese. one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 3" squares for HSTs.

#### From each of Fabrics I and J, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 2-1/2" squares for Corner Units. one 1-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: sixteen 1-7/8" squares for Flying Geese.

#### From Fabric K, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. four 1-1/2" x WOF\* strips. Subcut: two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom inner borders. two 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" side inner borders.

Note: If the usable width of your fabric is less than 42-1/2", you can sew the four WOF strips together, then subcut the border strips.

#### From Fabric L, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese.

#### From each of Fabrics M-O, Q, and R, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese.

#### From Fabric P, cut:

one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/4" squares for Flying Geese. six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut: two 4-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom outer borders. two 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" side outer borders

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

### Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric G square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line



creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixteen A/G HSTs.

Step 2: Repeat step 1 to make:













# Assemble the Flying Geese

Step 3: Pin two 2-7/8" Fabric E squares in opposing corners of a 5-1/4" Fabric A square, RST. The squares will overlap slightly in the center of the large square. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the squares.


Step 4: Sew scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set the seam by pressing it flat. Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.

**Step 5:** Press the fabric toward smaller triangles. Repeat with the second unit.

Step 6: Place one 2-7/8" Fabric E square at the corner of a sewn block unit. Draw a diagonal line in pencil. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set seam (press). Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.

Step 7: Press the seam toward the smaller triangle. Trim off small dog ears left by the seam allowance. Trim to 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" if necessary. Repeat to make four large A/E flying geese units.



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

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# **Step 9:** Repeat Steps 3-8 using 3-1/4" squares and 1-7/8" squares to make 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Flying Geese in the following combinations:

sixteen small A/I Flying Geese

Assemble the Corner Units

**Step 10:** Gather four 1-1/2" Fabric A squares, one 2-1/2" Fabric F square, and four small A/F Flying Geese. Arrange the squares and Flying Geese in three rows of three as shown. Sew the rows together, then press the seams towards the squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams towards the center of the Star Unit. Make four Fabric F Star Units.

**Step 11:** Gather four 1-1/2" Fabric A squares, one 2-1/2" Fabric I square, and four small A/I Flying Geese. Arrange the squares and Flying Geese in three rows of three as shown. Sew the rows together, then press the seams towards the squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams towards the center of the Star Unit. Make four Fabric I Star Units.

**Step 12:** Gather four 1-1/2" Fabric A squares, one 2-1/2" Fabric J square, and four small A/J Flying Geese. Arrange the squares and Flying Geese in three rows of three as shown. Sew the rows together, then press the seams towards the squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams towards the center of the Star Unit. Make four Fabric J Star Units.

**Step 13:** Gather one 1-1/2" Fabric A square, one A/D Flying Geese, and one 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew these pieces together to form a row as shown. Press the seams away from the Flying Geese.

**Step 14:** Gather one 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, one 2-1/2" Fabric D square, two A/D Flying Geese, and one A/G HST. Sew the pieces together to form a row as shown. Press the seams towards the Fabric A rectangle and Fabric D square.

**Step 15:** Gather one 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, one 4-1/2" Fabric A square, one small A/D Flying Geese, one E/F HST, and one F/G HST. Sew the Flying Geese to the top of the Fabric A rectangle, then press towards the

rectangle. Sew the two HSTs together to form a column as show. Press towards the bottom. Sew the two units you just created to opposite edges of the Fabric A square, then press towards the square.

**Step 16:** Gather one 2-1/2" Fabric E square, A/G HST, one E/F HST, and one F/G HST. Sew the pieces together to form a row as shown. Press the seams towards the outside of the row.

**Step 17:** Sew the Step 15 row to the top of the Step 16 row, then press the seam towards the top. Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the left side of the unit, then press towards the rectangle. Sew the Step 14 row to the top of the unit, then press towards the bottom. Sew the Step 13 row to the top of the unit, then press towards the bottom. Make four Large Star Point Units.

**Step 18:** Gather one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, one Fabric F Star Unit, and one Fabric I Star Unit. Sew the pieces together to form a row as shown. Press the seams towards the Fabric A rectangles. Make four rows.

**Step 19:** Gather one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, one 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, and one Fabric J Star Unit. Sew the pieces together to form a row, then press the seams towards the rectangles. Make four columns.

**Step 20:** Sew one Step 19 column to the left side of a Large Star Point Unit. Press the seam towards the left.

**Step 21:** Sew a Step 18 row to the top of a Step 20 unit. Press the seam towards the top of the unit. Make four Corner Units.


Press towards the top of the unit. Make four columns.

Step 22: Sew a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of an A/H HST as shown.

**Step 23:** Sew a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the top of an A/H HST as shown. Press towards the top of the unit. Make four columns.


**Step 24:** Gather two 2-1/2" Fabric A squares, one large C/H Flying Geese, one large E/C Flying Geese, one large H/A Flying Geese, four A/H HSTs, and two C/H HSTs. Sew the pieces in three rows of three as shown. Press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press towards the bottom of the unit. Make four units.














**Step 25:** Sew a Step 24 unit between a Step 22 column and Step 23 column. Press the seams towards the outside. Make four Upper Units.

**Step 26:** Gather one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, one large A/E Flying Geese, one large E/D Flying Geese, two A/F HSTs, A/G HSTs, four D/E HSTs, four E/F HSTs, and two F/G HSTs. Sew the pieces in four rows as shown. Press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press towards the bottom of the unit. Make four Bottom Units.

**Step 27:** Sew a Step 25 Upper Unit to the top of a Step 26 Bottom Unit. Press towards the bottom. Make four Side Units.

# Assemble the Center Unit


**Step 28:** Gather one 4-1/2" Fabric B square, four 2-1/2" Fabric C squares, four 2-1/2" Fabric D squares, four C/B Flying Geese, four D/C Flying Geese, and eight C/D HSTs. Sew the pieces in five rows of five as shown. Press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press to complete the Center Unit

# Assemble the Pieced Borders


**Step 30:** Sew two large L/A Flying Geese together as shown. Press towards the bottom. Make four units.



**Step 31:** Sew three large E/A Flying Geese, three large P/A Flying Geese, three large K/A Flying Geese, three large G/A Flying Geese, three large L/A Flying Geese, three large Q/A Flying Geese, and three large R/A Flying Geese together in that order to form a row. Press the seams towards the left. Make two side pieced borders.



**Step 32:** Sew one Step 30 unit, three large D/A Flying Geese, three large C/A Flying Geese, three large B/A Flying Geese, three large M/A Flying Geese, three large O/A Flying Geese, three large F/A Flying Geese, and one Step 30 unit together in that order to form a row. Press the seams towards the left. Make two top/bottom pieced borders.



Center Units in three rows of three as shown. Press the seams towards the Side Units. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams towards the center of the quilt.

Step 29: Sew the Corner, Side, and

Assemble the Quilt



**Step 33:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 34:** Sew the side pieced borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom pieced borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 35:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
